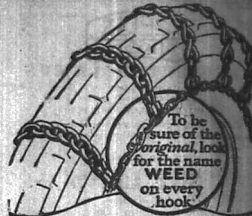

The Geological Survey Department of Tanganyika Territory in addition to issuing a general report for the year 1920, have also published a number of short papers dealing with the geology and the mineral occurrences in the territory with the object of making available as soon as possible information likely to be of value to all who are interested in the mineral development of the Colony.

Others awaiting further development or investigation include coal, tin, copper, iron, graphite, asbestos and pyrites. In addition other minerals such as corundum, graphite, manganese minerals, phosphoric, barium, bismuth, fluor, spar, amethyst and tourmaline have been recorded.

East African Exports.

FIGURES OF RAILWAY TRAFFIC.

The following statement shows the tonnage of the principal export commodities consigned to the Coast from up-country stations and Port during April 1926 and 1925.

There was an increase of 16 tons of coffee, 501 tons having been received at the Coast in April 1926 and 707 tons in 1925. Cotton increased by 150 tons, 1926 being 1,290 tons and 1925, 6,419 tons. Cotton seeds showed the very large increase of 8,404 tons, 3,697 tons being received during 1926 and 12,101 tons in 1925. Fibre had increased a nil ton in 1926 and 44 tons in 1925. Fibre seed increased by 223 tons, 1926 being 1926 tons and 1925, 1,511 tons. Seven tons of groundnuts were received at the Coast in 1926, none having been received in the corresponding month of the previous year. Rubber decreased from 221 tons in 1926 to 427 tons in 1925, a decrease of 64 tons. There was a big increase in iron ore, 1926 being 2,278 tons and 1925, 1,420 tons. Rice was increased from 100 tons in 1926 to 120 tons in 1925, an increase of 212 tons. Variable bulk decreased by 50 tons, 1926 being 200 tons and 1925, 173 tons. Wool decreased from 17 tons in 1926 to 27 tons in 1925.

It is interesting occasionally to ascertain whether there is any increase in the bushiness of the steering wheel. Even when a car is new there is generally a certain amount of bushiness, say a 1/16 inch, but this should increase if it is not sufficiently tight to be hardly noticeable until it has become irritating.

The method of testing suggested by the above is to hold the rim of the wheel or otherwise securely make it tight, to hold a pointer such as a lead pencil or wire and adjust front fork portion of the body-work, and with a steel rule to measure the actual discharge through which the wheel travels before it is pulled up in this direction.

The tendency nowadays to use spring covers with air inlets for steering knuckles is a bad thing which will allow whether they are becoming soft and thereby aiding for attention. 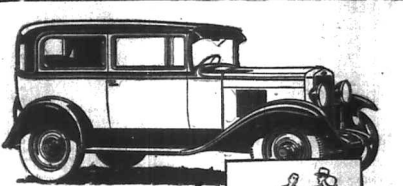
