THE ART OF CORNERING

A Fruitful Cause of Road Accidents.

TECHNICAL AND SAFETY TIPS FACTS

Of the various aspects from which really safe driving may be viewed, that of cornering is the one considered in the detail in this issue of "The East African Standard." With the advent of four-wheel braking and other springing and steering improvements, the standard of driving on corners has become so high that, in fact, there is a growing tendency on the part of some drivers to take the road too slow and not to vary it afterwards. This is a dangerous assumption.

Before discussing actual cornering methods, both good and bad, let us review into a safe issue which is frequently entirely given, namely, the "steering" of the chassis and so on caused by brutal cornering.

The degree of strain will depend upon the speed maintained by the car and the acuteness of the bend. But it should be understood that to take a left-hand right-angle turn, at the same rate of speed, say, 30 m.p.h., is not for trouble in anything but a very slight manner.

The trouble would probably be that the chassis would be so severely shaken that it could not hold its weight. It may also be that the chassis would be so severely shaken that it would be unable to support the weight of the chassis and so on.

When turning a corner the driver should be in a position to see the effects of centrifugal force. This involves a twisting strain in the leaves, for they have to accommodate themselves to the change in the differential of the plane of the axle seating and body to accommodate respectively. Added to this, the shock absorbers have to absorb the shock of the whole body to slide sideways off the chassis, so that the effects of the quarter-elliptic springs on the axle of the motor car is increased owing to the leverage caused by the difference in the effective length of the leaves and the length of the spring. The strain is also communicated to the wheel bearings, the spokes of the wheels—its equivalent—and so on.

In the old days, frequently used as a kind of indicator, before the strain of fast cornering on a dry surface became great enough to cause any other trouble one or more tyres would roll off the rim, but the result was, of course, often just as regrettable. Modern vehicles and tyres are more perfect than this, but they cannot be expected indefinitely to stand such unnecessary strains, and the tyre, at any rate, may suffer. Naturally, the steering gear comes in for a fair share of the load, which may be the body—especially if it is of the saloon type—will have to resist the excessive application of centrifugal force.

Here, perhaps, it would be as well frankly to admit that modern chassis are not so well designed, without further ado, where natural or artificial loads are employed, but they are subjected to the strain we have mentioned all the same, and it is well that private owners should be acquainted with the safe sense of the best cornering.

The disposition of the feet on the controls is important. On a severe corner both hands will probably be required for steering, and if the "feet" on the accelerator there may not be sufficient time to transfer it to the foot brake to avoid a reckless driver, or even if the correct direction who is attempting to cut the corner. A better speed for the driver who is descending the hill is obviously essential, for the radius in which the car has to turn is very much smaller.

This applies to a really dangerous kind of corner, but it is not dangerous—as the photograph shows—where the driver is not suddenly pulling out for the off-side previous to making the turn as he will have every inch of the road to clear. It is a good plan to change down in plenty of time and to roll up to the limit of the right foot "as the ready" on the brake. If the car is to be stopped, the right foot can be transferred to the accelerator without any time.

REPAIRING SCREEN-WIPER TURNING

Owing to being chafed by the forward part of a blind-bent, the rubber tube connecting a screen wiper to the induction pipe sometimes wears through, causing the wiper to cease functioning. Also setting up an air leak to the engine, which may affect the ignition. A temporary cure may be effected by binding the wiper with a permanent plaster. To make a permanent repair which will eliminate the chance of any further trouble, cut about an inch out of the tube and insert a length of small copper pipe.

A NOVEL GENERATOR SYSTEM

There is still a large number of cars in use which are fitted with the old-fashioned screw-down gear type of lubricator. Readers who own such cars will be interested in a cheap and easy conversion into the "variable pressure" system. The idea consists in the simply drilling holes in the centre of the cap, and fitting nipples to them. To fill the caps it is necessary only to apply the grease pump to the nipple in the orthodox manner. By the pressure pump should be flooded the cap can be removed in light and the full pressure of the gun exerted.



London's New Underground.

GOODS RAILWAY BEING PUSHED FORWARD.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT. London, Aug. 8.] The much talked of "Underground Goods Railway" is being pushed forward rapidly and it is said that the Admiralty will be asked to purchase the line. It is published in a day or two. It is said that the work will employ 10,000 men for four years and Mr. Thomas, the Lord Privy Seal, considers the scheme of such paramount importance that he has set up an enquiry committee to report upon it without delay.

The underground railway will cover some 72 miles of track and will save 54 public stations for the reception and delivery of goods. In some cases traffic will be lifted direct from the stations to the packing rooms of the big department stores. It is to be hoped that the railway will be completed with as little delay as possible because it will relieve traffic congestion in the London streets to a quite inappreciable extent.

Admiral Food

STRANGE REVELATIONS IN OFFICIAL REPORT.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT. London, Aug. 8.] Some strange revelations are made in the report of the Ministry of Health for the week ending July 31, which was issued this week. It contains a sample of food and drugs examined, 7994 were adulterated, a proportion of 2.8 per cent., compared with 1.5 per cent. for 1927. MEW was the principal victim, 4.3 per cent. of cases of adulteration being discovered.

Among other curious discoveries, one sample of flour was reported to contain a considerable amount of fungus, and two samples of an article sold as egg flour were found to consist of self-raising flour with a small per cent. of coloured matter, but no egg.

"Mashed" was found to contain wheat flour, or maize starch, and sand was reported among added ingredients. "A sample of cod liver oil tablets," it is stated, "were again reported to contain wax to disguise the oil and other things. In the last year in England, one hundred and twenty-three samples of this kind were analysed and 111 reported to contain adulterated contents."

STAGHURTING PROTESTS COMMENCE.

Opening of the Season in England.

A DIFFICULT QUESTION.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT. London, Aug. 8.] With the resumption of staghunting we have had the usual boisterous protests and anti-hunting demonstrations were reported for the opening meet of the Devon and Somerset stag-hounds this week which was smaller than usual. It has been announced, however, that the Hunt Committee has now decided to kill the stag at the end of the chase by shooting, instead of with the knife, when possible, and for this purpose the second hornless carries a rifle.

It is thought that this concession to the feelings of people opposed to staghunting will be appreciated. Now, when the stag has to be watered the hounds will be taken off and the stag shot at once instead of being hunted up and down stream.

A protest meeting was held early this week at Bowditch against the resumption of stag-hunting on Dartmoor. Mrs. Margaret Bondfield, M.P., the Minister of Labour has definitely taken sides with the protesters since she wrote to the meeting that she was thankful to know that opposition to this sport was growing, and she said looking forward to introducing a Bill to be read from the House on July 15. Mr. V. Alexander the First Lord of the Admiralty, also wrote expressing his entire sympathy with the movement.

Opposition to Sport Growing.

Opposition to this form of sport is evidently going to be a great deal this year as it was last, and all sides will watch anxiously any further developments, though the opposition made may probably make the opposition less.

The whole question is, of course, a very difficult one. No-body wants to be cruel to any animal and the cause of cruelty brought up are on the whole isolated. There are cruel humans and it would be unkind to say animal whether it was a domestic dog or whether they were hunting. There is no doubt that if staghunting were not hunting of the kind, the majority of them would have to be exterminated, and the question is whether it is better to hunt them or to kill them. There are certain extremists about who allow their feelings to run away with their reason, and they do their cause a great deal of harm. On the whole I think the concession made will cheer the air, and I do not think the protest this year will be nearly as great as they were last.

Two-Seater Taxis.

SHORTLY TO APPEAR ON LONDON STREET.

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT. London, Aug. 8.] A fleet of two-seater taxis of quite unusual design is shortly to be placed on the London streets. These cabs, which were invented by a Mr. Owen of Cape Town, are built on a heavy chassis and instead of doors have two sliding panels which close the front part of the passenger compartment. 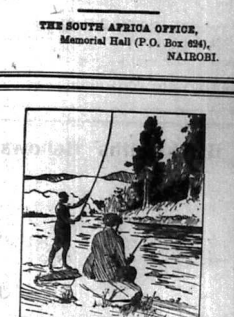

LOCUST CAMPAIGN IN KENYA
Swarms Reported in the Kiaya Reserve.
HOPPER DISEASE.
The Department of Agriculture reports that a large swarm of red locusts is reported in the Kiaya Reserve, where damage has been done to maize, but elsewhere in Kenya the situation is well in hand.
The following is the departmental report for the week ending September 4:-
Flying Locusts.

A very thin swarm is reported from Oltit.
The remnants of a South-western swarm have departed in a westerly direction. The damage done by this swarm, which has been moving about in Kiaya's Valley for nearly three weeks, is almost negligible, and the heavy damage reported in some districts previously is now confined to a few flying locusts. Some of the left behind large numbers of dead or dying locusts. Some of the sick locusts are infested with what appears to be a throat micro-organism which swells up and turns a creamy-white colour. They then waste away. What appears to be some eating larvae on the maize is now frequently found to consist of large numbers of dead locusts clinging to the plants. These which are found on the ground are surrounded by a fine white powder. This description fits and descriptions of trees full of dead locusts in the Beraga District.
It is clear that with the hopper disease, the parasites of flying locusts, and also some of the hopper parasites, together with a possible fungal infection, the most breeding area in the Rift Valley from Kamukia to Kajiado, is becoming insupportable for as locusts are concerned.
It will be recalled that parous locust swarms were first in the Masai Reserve in the early part of the year, and also in the Kiaya Reserve. Some hopper sickness was also reported from that country earlier in this campaign.
There are no further reports of flying swarms, movements, and from Tanganyika there is nothing to be reported on and across.
Hopper and Laying Areas.
Northern Parkia. Reports four square miles of laying at Loro, and two square miles at Loko. The hatching on the African River Valley is considerable and the infestation has been done. The hatching was done in the new area mentioned above. In this the hatching and destruction is left to the discretion of Local Officers.
Southern Parkia. No reports, but news has come through that locusts have been established with the workers in Haringo, who are operating on seed areas.
Pak. Choborok news infestation is heavy and fresh hatching have taken place. One infestation is reported as being three miles across. Heavy rain has been falling and spraying are carried out in this area.
Elgeyo and Marogot. Now reported practically clear of hoppers. Two flying swarms have been seen. One has been moving into the Kiaya Valley into Kamukia. Rain has again fallen in Elgeyo. Here, spraying is considered most effective on hoppers, and has been being on young flying swarms.

Harigo. In the Lalayo-Karukka area Officers are concentrated. Territorial rains have fallen, interrupting transport considerably. All old hopper areas now clear, and work is proceeding vigorously along the west bank of the Ruirua River. There are some scattered and ranges from half an acre to one acre in size. Five more Officers re-infesting these already mentioned have arrived. Two flying swarms of red and yellow locusts have been reported by hatching, one at Mar-Ober and one at Nganyang. These areas are moving south and south-east in the Rift Valley. In this area spraying and killing are used extensively.
Northern Parkia. No work has been set up.
The Masai section that is a vast of locusts to a "Fly" area is allowed to kill the flies and the grass is safe for cattle for some years. It will be interesting to see if they use known "Fly" areas for grazing in the area future.

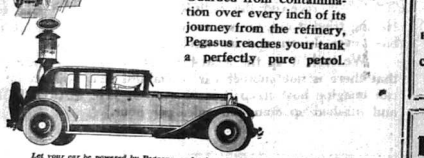

SAVOURIES.

(By an East African Housewife.)

Savouries are very little trouble to prepare, and as the individual portions are so small, they need not add unduly to the cost of a dinner, though they can do much to add to the success of it.

Pepper, one egg slightly beaten, two tablespoonful milk, and one tablespoonful of butter.

Tomato and Egg Toast.

Put two tomatoes into boiling water for a few minutes. Take out and remove the skins. To a tablespoonful of melted butter, add the tomatoes one tablespoonful of minced ham, and a teaspoonful of minced onion.

Prison Whisk.

This is a quick savoury which must be prepared the day before it is required. Make quarter of a pint of apple jelly, according to the directions on the packet, and allow to cool. Add two tablespoonful of tomato, one and a half of onion, and one of celery.

Eggs in Cases.

Melt two tablespoonful of butter in a pan, and add a level tablespoonful of flour. Cook for a few minutes and add a break of fat, a dash of salt, and a dash of paprika.

Chow Peas. Heat one egg lightly, and add one ounce of ground cheese, half an ounce of breadcrumbs, and one ounce of bread crumbs.

Chow Steaks. These are mostly always popular and are very easy to make. Boil a tablespoonful of butter into a small saucepan.

Scotch Woodcock. Cut well-browned toast into small squares, and spread with soft butter. Season the yolks with salt and pepper.

Baldock Defeats Belgian Opponent.

AMERICAN CHALLENGE TO B.B.O.

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT, London, Aug. 10.

Toddy Baldock, British pugilist, continued his fight against the Belgian champion, before 12,000 spectators, at a contest scheduled for fifteen 3-minute rounds at 9 a.m. in the Victoria stadium, last evening.

Baldock started as determined to end the fight quickly, but he was unable to force his opponent immediately to fight hard, although he was in light and reach, he was not lacking in aggressiveness, but he was almost soundly best scientifically. Baldock being greatly superior in timing, and vastly faster with hands and feet. His feinting straight lefts were consistently finding the Belgian's face, but his attempts to land a right cross to the chin were frustrated by Potteus's shrewd cover and quizzical dodging of the head.

Actually there was one moment between the two in which Baldock boxed beautifully in attack, but his defence and avoidance were so smart that time was again Potteus was made to miss by feet, and several times considered to the ropes through the champion's deft side-stepping. Occasionally Potteus landed lefts swinging to the side of the head, but other than that his leads were wild or short. His punch was wonderful, for it, though assailed by fast two-handed attacks, he stood his ground manfully, and sometimes scored on the break.

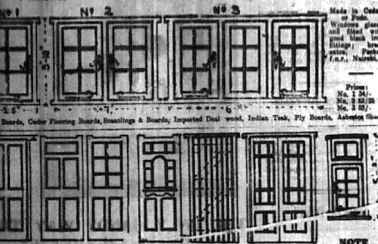

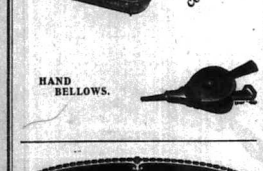
