GOOD PROSPECTS FOR WHEAT FARMERS.

(STANDARD CORRESPONDENT).
The rain recorded in our last week, and rain on the 30th, again, and rains are liable to continue for some time. Moisture is generally, beyond the usual amount, and should require the state of things before leaving Nairobi on my country.

In experienced during the first half of the month, it will be the wheat growers' year and a world of good, and now the wheat is in the ground in place of wheat.

Changing Crops.

This is really surprising how some farmers chop and change about with their crops, not for rotation purposes, but because one year or the other happens to be in price at the moment. Thus wheat two years ago when went up to 20/- per bush, a lot of maize growers fall in the price of wheat during the last two years and the high price rising for maize many farmers have rubbed back to maize.

This can only be a foolish policy since nobody can tell what the price of either crop is likely to be in the following year, and those who chop and change are more likely to strike the lower price than the advantage of the higher price in the alternate years. If such a course is to be adopted it is probably better to follow in a bad year in one crop with that same crop at from the law of averages that crop which is low in price one year is more likely to be the following year and vice versa.

The same policy used to be adopted in England by a lot of farmers and it used to be more or less a maxim among the more astute always to follow up a bad year in any particular crop with that crop in the next year. This year in Kenya has every prospect at present of further demonstrating how the law of averages stands to work with crops by the latest crop which is low in price with the law in England follows the very low price last year.

GOOD SHELLS TO EGGS.

An Important Factor.

It is a most important factor in the production of high quality eggs for that the shells are of proper texture. Nature has conspired to make the pocket outside her product in a sealed packet, but with the keeping of eggs in confinement it is necessary for us to provide her with material to make the pocket good and strong.

This porous shelled egg causes rapid evaporation and will not keep good for long as a good hard shelled egg. If laid up to a light this type of egg shows what appears to be minute holes all over it. These are places where the shell is so thin that it becomes very much more porous than it is in the ordinary way and it will absorb any bad odours, etc., that may be caught therefore causing it to become less suitable for consumption than the thick shelled egg which has more protection from outside contamination.

If such eggs are sold by weight, it will be found that they quickly lose weight, and also the percentage of breakage in packing will be increased.

Cause of Porous Shelled Eggs.
 The cause of porous shelled eggs is 30 per cent brooding. If porous shelled eggs are incubated then there will be an increase of layers of such eggs in the next generation.

A normal cock will produce about 50 per cent daily supply of eggs. These hens will require approximately 10 lbs. of shell producing material to every 100 lbs. of egg. This is a certain amount of shell forming material which the hen must obtain from an organic source (living organism). The hen appears to be better able to assimilate and use the calcium and phosphorus from this source than from the mineral or inorganic source. The calcium from green foods and the phosphoric compounds of calcium from bone meal will supply these.

The grit box will supply the hen with the means to grind her food and will supply her with any extra shell forming material she requires. Many people favour the use of egg lime oil, and it certainly provides good shell forming mate-

rial. Personally, though I am in favour of it for some forming in children, I am rather doubtful of it in the laying pen, it is so easy to get the egg contaminated with anything by using anything of pronounced odour or taste in the food.

This shelled or shelled egg are an absolute bugbear to the chicken; it is not much more than the loss of point of view, as in a domestic run poultry farm, they seldom occur, but from the risk of starting egg eating, a complaint which is most difficult to get rid of once it is started.

Egg Eating.

A short time ago I had a case of this. I always collect the eggs myself. One day just before going out in the afternoon I saw a hen laying; I was delayed and got back rather late, but when I went to collect the eggs there was no sign of the egg which should have been in the house. I kept a very sharp look out and discovered that it was the very hen I had seen in the afternoon, if it had been an indifferent hen, she would have died suddenly, as that is the best cure. But she was a valuable hen so I did not want to lose her. I placed her in solitary confinement and increased her allowance of shell forming material, also giving her an egg well filled with mustard and quinine to play with. She was watched and as soon as she laid her egg it was removed. After giving her two doctored eggs, and a weak military confinement, I replaced her in the pen and have had no further trouble. It is only when the view is looked at the very first that it can be cured so simply as this. It is very infectious, and if not stopped at the whole nest of the pen will be waiting on each hen in order to eat her egg so soon as it is laid.

When anyone tells me, that although their hens look as if they are laying, yet they are getting very few eggs, and that the boy who has been at feeding them, I always suspect egg eating. It is not necessary that there are fragments of egg left behind, as I have known the birds to do so every evening, sometimes they even leaving a small patch in the case.

From Road & Showroom.

YOUR FIRST MOTOR CYCLE

Points to Watch and Remember.

CURING MECHANICAL TROUBLES.

Every year some thousands of people becoming motor cyclists, and the large majority join the movement as complete novices. The word "novice" suggests an inexperienced rider who is baffled by all but the simplest realities that he is likely to encounter. But how many motor cyclists realize that there is an enormous number of new riders who are novices even more truly than that? There are those who are baffled by the simplest theories. It is difficult even for a rider of six or ten years' experience to realize the truth of this statement, this is because experience is accumulated as rapidly that one's own "feelings" misleads in the early months of owning the first machine as one completely forgets almost as soon as they are made.

It is with the object of assisting these true novices—such as the ones who, in use an unjustly derisive expression, "do not know a cycle from a mop" or "that they few notes appear. Therefore, he who distinguishes these two components apart can turn over the page forthwith, for this article will not interest him. In the first place, it is important that the novice should have at least a rough idea of what happens inside his engine. It is

true that there are quite a number of motor cyclists who have not, but it is an undeniable fact that such knowledge is of great assistance when it comes to tracing troubles.

First of all a word of encouragement. Let not the novice, reading this long tale of trouble, be discouraged. It is a hundred-fold more chance that his mount will not come to him down on the road during a season's riding; but there is still the old chance, and experience costs little.

And now let us suppose that you are on the road with your new machine and let us consider some of the little difficulties you may encounter.

Take for example starting. Machines vary according to particular engine and construction, so you cannot do better than to follow the instructions given with your particular machine. If you have a second-hand machine and have no "book of marks" (that do not forget that these books are often obtainable from the manufacturers for a shilling or so), you will have to find the best method by experiment. As a general rule remember that there are two exceptions—a successful start can be obtained by setting the throttle lever above the normal position, and keeping the air lever closed. Any machine that the control cables will of course play an important part, or other more or less "theoretical" opening may be necessary.

Suppose that the machine refuses to start after repeated attempts; if you have of course, had flooding the carburettor by means of the "choke" on the down chamber (this, in most cases, as the usual preliminary to starting, though it would not be overdone).

Possibly during the unseasonable months the piston will have

drawn a great deal of liquid petrol into the cylinder; whenever, try starting with the throttle nearly closed but with a generous setting of the air lever. If this fails try the same method, but with the kick-starter until you feel resistance to the compression. Then lift the exhaust valve by means of the lever on the handlebar and depress the kick-starter. Repeat as often further; allow the kick-starter to return, then drop the exhaust lifter and start give one good, hefty try.

In the case of two-stroke machines repeated unloading of the cylinder at starting may result in the crank case becoming flooded with petrol, which will make starting an extremely problematical thing until matters are put right.

A Question of Adjustment.

The cone in the intake lever is getting rid of the excess petrol. A simple method is to turn off the petrol, let the cone, and any throttle controls, as their fullest extent, and then operate the kick-starter for a minute or two with the "choke lever" held up.

The excess of petrol will thus be passed into the siphon, and when the mixture becomes weak enough the engine will probably start with a roar. Close the throttle until it runs steadily. Instead of using the kick-starter you can push the machine along a few yards with outside gear engaged and the air lever raised lower level.

If these methods fail, and you are not sure, has not previously been a feature of the machine, you may suspect the setting of the pilot jet. First jet carburettors are fitted to the majority of machines made during recent years.

As a rule the jet adjustment is by means of a small milled screw at the side of the carburettor body. For an explanation of its working consult the carburettor maker's instruction book.

We will assume that you are not a fanatic on the matter and are travelling seriously when an adjustment of this kind is necessary. To an even slightly experienced rider the adjustment of this kind is not so difficult as it will seem, as to the nature of the trouble, but we will not attempt to give a full account. Next make sure that it is coming through the pilot jet; depress the cone and the top of the carburettor float chamber, and see whether petrol issues from the carburettor. You will very probably find that the carburettor is receiving enough petrol, so before proceeding further with any investigations into matters of jet adjustment, first examine the points.

If you find that the plug is very wet, and that the mixture in the points is bridged by burnt oil, you will find some cause for the trouble. Alternatively, you may find some cause for the trouble bridged by a "whisker" of metal which is hanging between the first two points. It is a thoroughly first-rate piece of work, and is not so innocuous a condition, lay it on top of the piston, with the high-tension coil connected, but do not touch the mixture in the case of the coil and the plug terminal to become a coil, and the body of the plug must touch. Now operate the kick-starter, and watch for any spark at the points in the top of the piston, and also the body of the plug, it should be normally "taken out" with the high-tension coil, and the insulator tube, taken to pieces and cleaned.

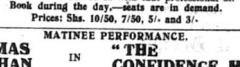

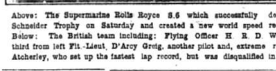

Agriculture. SOIL PROBLEMS. Conditions Affecting Arable Land.

Professor I. de V. Matherie, of Stellenbosch University is venturing a recent discussion at Cape Town in the Agricultural Journal of the British Association, some of the outstanding problems of the soil of the South African arable farmer, said that in this connection it was essential to have at least some knowledge of the climatic conditions; more particularly of the rainfall.

About half of the Union averaged less than twenty inches of rainfall during the year. From an annual rainfall of twenty-five inches was in many areas insufficient for the production of regular field crops, since the precipitation was so erratic, and concentrated in some short periods that its efficiency for agricultural crops was very low.

Lack of Phosphate. Phosphate supply in the so-called grain soils of the south-western Cape Province, the area upon which the Union was chiefly dependent for its wheat production, were very unfavourably supplied with phosphate, no matter from what source that plant-food was studied. Numerous experiments had demonstrated the great deficiency and farmers were advised to use up to 100 lbs. of superphosphate or bone ash per acre.

In the northern Province, especially in Natal, heavy soil and loams were frequently encountered, and it had been found that superphosphate seems to be more unavailable in that type of soil than other than water-soluble phosphates should be applied. In the more arid regions of the Union, the soils in some of the whole alkaline and in some places, especially in alluvial soils, the phosphate content might be fairly high.

The grain crops, the potato content of the above soils was more than sufficient, and it was possible to potash treatment had not been definitely shown in fertilizer experiments on the typical gravity loam.

Water. South African soils, especially the upland and plateau, were well served in potash, exceptions in this general rule were the sandy soils of the more humid coast, and the quartz coastal dunes and in the Nieuwenburg district.

found throughout the Union that although the soils might be deficient in nitrogen, as judged by ordinary standards, the application of anything but moderate dressings of nitrogen to annual crops early in the season was very risky procedure. In the winter cultivation in the case of the summer rainfall area, the question of nitrogen fixation was closely connected with that of the water supply. In the summer rainfall area there was in addition the greater utilization and probably greater bacterial fixation of nitrogen in the warm, moist soils, as also a greater supply from the heavens (thunderstorms).

The grain lands of the south-western Cape were in general only slightly acid and gave a fair proportion of them, especially in the arid and semi-arid western section, were more or less neutral or slightly alkaline.

Lime experiments in the past had given no positive results with grain. The slight improvement which might come in the structure of the soil did not, under the present cropping system, warrant its application economically.

Water Supply.

Moisture shortage at some critical period was the link in crop production in South Africa, and responsible for the tremendous fluctuations in yields which were so characteristic of the country's arable farming. Water shortage was the cause of crop failure even in the production of cereal crops in the south-west. Cape districts which received a seasonal precipitation of fifteen to twenty-five inches of rainfall.

It would appear, however, that there was great room for improvement in the cultural methods adopted on grain lands.

Cultural Methods.

As the result of soil cultivation and crop rotation experiments by the Rothchild-Blenheim College of Agriculture, the following points were suggested and were warranted: (a) Grain soils should be ploughed immediately after the cultivation and have still more, but it would be advantageous to plough in the autumn.

could; (b) the ordinary plough, and especially the disc plough, should be discarded when preparing the seed-bed of winter-sown fallow (washed) lands, and in their stead spring-tough cultivators should be used. In other words, an adaptation of the New South Wales method of grain-land cultivation would seem to give a long way towards increasing the making tendency of the surface soil, but the working of a soil and sub-soil which would receive and store up the moisture much more efficiently.

Orchard and Vineyard Soils.

Soils planted to fruit trees and vines in the south-western Cape showed more greater diversity in depth, texture, plant-food, local organic matter and reaction than the prevailing neutral grain soils. In some cases grape and nut matured during the early summer months, and the green in parts of orchards and vineyards were not irrigated, conservation of water soil moisture through close cultivation in summer was essential. An application of phosphate, potash and, where necessary, lime, should be made more regularly in autumn for the purpose of obtaining a good winter cover crop of fruit as was a simultaneously possible which reduced soil erosion and long transport well.

Application of Nitrogen.

The nature of the nitrogenous fertilizer and the time of its application were very important factors so far as the healthy growth of the tree and the quality of the fruit were concerned. Soluble organic nitrogen was no longer the goal for leaving trees and vines.

Where required, a quick-acting form of nitrogen should be applied in early spring. Their investigations had revealed the main factors pertaining to the possible nitrate cycle obtaining in "grain" arable soils of this region. The partial sterilization effect of during summer caused a very high nitrate peak immediately after the first good soaking of the soil by the autumn rain (March-April).

A cover crop was therefore essential in winter for utilizing the soil nitrate and for the production of organic matter. In this respect the common "problem" (Corynephorus subulmaria) was a native winter cover crop in certain parts of the Union had been found to be the most economical plan. Being a non-irrigated, it should however, be ploughed under earlier than a legume in order to avoid possible nitrate fixation by the autumn rain.

Seldom has the East African public had an opportunity of viewing wealth in gold, diamonds, precious stones and minerals such as that offered by the Exhibition in Tanganyika last week.

There were twenty diamonds from Mwanza in closely protected cases, large nuggets of gold from the Lupia, garnets from Lindi, coal from Kipona Province, copper from the Lake Nyasa area and mica and radio-active minerals from other parts of the Territory.

The exhibit staged by the Geological Department, fascinating and romantic as all mineral exhibits are, was also so significant of the industrial future which will change the face of Tanganyika—and East Africa.

PROMISE OF THE FUTURE.

The Mineral Division, which was a joint exhibit of the Mines Department and the Geological Department, Dodoma, was staged in a substantial stone building for very adequate reasons which will appear later. The greatest of Tanganyika is covered by rocks of pre-Cambrian age mostly schists, gneiss and granite. The soils produced from these are of course a climatic reaction, varying considerably in the different altitudes being a fact which is of great importance to the higher of the Territory. The Geological Department, which is the only one of its kind in the South and North Rhodesias, has been developing in the past few years to an advanced stage. This is shown in a remarkable way by the considerable adaptation that considerable progress has been made in the scientific development of the mineral resources of Tanganyika. The Board of Deputies of British Jews has passed a resolution urging Government to ensure that the policy of establishing a Jewish national home in Palestine becomes a principle governing the administration of Palestine, to remove from their posts officials who are opposed to the policy of the Mandate and to take effective steps to ensure the right of Jewish worship at the "Wailing Wall" in Jerusalem without interference, to punish officials who are guilty of violence and to render adequate reparations to sufferers from the recent riots.

Jerusalem, Sept. 8. As evidence of the absence of any intention to disturb the Jews without interference, to punish officials who are guilty of violence and to render adequate reparations to sufferers from the recent riots.

ARTS AND CRAFTS OF THE AFRICAN NATIVE.
 Enlightening Displays in Durce-Salaam.
FRUITS OF INDUSTRY.
 The Handicrafts of the European and Indian Peoples.

"P" MOMBASA
 One of the most interesting and also the most instructive exhibits at the Tanganyika Agricultural and Industrial Exhibition held at Durce-Salaam comprises the Handicrafts of the European and Indian Peoples. It was organized by the Women's Service League. It is curious that of all the sections included in this exhibit that which received the most support was the cookery. Other parts of this display were devoted to needlework, jessie exhibits, native basket work, woodwork and carving, weaving, leather work and hand made work by the various native schools, carpentry, lathe-work, book-binding and drawing.

The section was the largest in the whole show and had been very well supported by visitors from all parts of the Territory. Their work showed remarkable skill and was a little interesting.

For Competition.
 The classes for competitive exhibits from native schools included splendid examples of basket work of every imaginable size and shape, beautiful bead work, articles made in basketed containers, delicate glass work, useful brushes, an excellent inlaid table, simple soap and stockings. Among the schools competing in this class were the Bugler's Girls School, the Daganzo Mission, the Mental Hospital at Dodoma, the Kabonzi Mission, the Ngata Mission and the St. Martin's School.

To detail the items found in all the various classes would be impossible as a comprehensive examination of them all would have occupied very many hours. But certain items were outstanding. There was an excellent section of native made grain baskets and ornamental baskets of many different kinds and patterns, and of varied colours. Another section was devoted to carved bottles or table vessels and amongst these much ingenuity was apparent. The class for "any figure carved in wood or other matter" drew a number of entries, very numerous in amount and many of them of a high degree of skill. Some were crude and harsh but one or two were really beautiful pieces of work which showed immense skill.

hand with much labour. Leather work provided for cross-hatched shoes a very large number of entries. The leather work turned out good. The ordinary hand work classes were poor both in quality and in the number of entries.

One very unusual and interesting feature was the exhibit by the White Fathers of some rope and mats made from steel. All the entries in these classes were from the same source and included wool and rug mats. They were beautifully constructed.

The European Site.
 The European section included some beautiful needle-work, and it is interesting to record that in this and other classes in the same section many exhibitors received prizes had come from the neighbouring territory of Kenya. There were a number of exhibits from the Ki-lima School. It is surprising that the ladies and schools of Kenya had done everything possible to support these sections. Two special prizes presented by Lady Cameron, who was one of the Judges, went to Kenya.

A stall which aroused much amusement was devoted to toys made by the competitors. There were woolly lambs, various looking ducks, pelicans, and a host of other things that would delight children. Another section worthy of special mention was devoted to Handicrafts and Glass work. Amongst the former was some very beautiful work exhibited by a Kenya lady and in the latter delightfully painted boxes and candlesticks.

A display by the Julius Njikoi School included a variety of cushions of different colors. The Art Section was particularly good, the number of entries being large and the standard of work very high. In addition to drawings and paintings of a wide range of subjects there were many other articles in this most adjoining part of the Handicrafts section which aroused admiration. In the same way a large model, some six feet by four, of the proposed new Native and Indian Exhibition at Durce-Salaam. This had been drawn and modelled by Mr. John Choboni, A.I.A., and was a splendid illustration of the development going on at the Coast.

Besides some paintings of ships a number of delicate models were exhibited, although not for

position. One of these was designed as a miniature and had fitted with water.

An exhibit of outstanding merit was a series of drawings by an artist from the Durce-Salaam. Some paintings by the same gentleman were of great merit and although beautifully executed were a little difficult to understand, so far as the European were concerned.

The photographic section was poor, very few negatives having been entered. These exhibited showed good work, but it is hoped that at subsequent Shows a far larger entry will be received.

Another unique exhibit was that of some flowers made out of painted shells. These attracted a considerable amount of very favourable comment.

School Work.
 In another of the stone buildings other sections were housed. These included furniture done by native school boys, the work being remarkably fine. There were chairs and tables, desks, bookcases, etc. Some were from the Durce-Salaam Railway Workshops and others by the Tabors Railway Workshops and the U.M.C. of Mombasa.

Other classes consisted of a variety of articles constructed and useful and a large range of square of all sizes. There was an interesting exhibit of bark cloth from the Durce-Salaam resident photographs of the Mohi Central School were shown. Although these were not competitive, the entire of the development in education which is going on in the country was admirably and clearly conveyed.

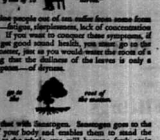

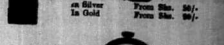
