COMING CONFERENCE ON UGANDA COTTON.

(Continued from page 1.)

may call the more sophisticated parts of the country another Uganda, and those evicted from the East a strong hostility to the idea of a combination or combination among the natives, believing that the object of such combinations was not to bring about increased efficiency and to secure more money for the growers and ginners, but was intended purely for the benefit of ginners in order to strengthen their position against the producer and place the latter according to the prevailing accepted belief at the mercy of a ring. This feeling of the part of the present session to have been fostered by propaganda issued by Indian missionaries who naturally see that the effect of more general combination will be a considerable reduction in their own missionaries' profits.

A tendency to mistrust of the existing combination was perceptible in 1920 but was much repressed especially in Buganda. In 1920, according to statements issued by the P. C. Buganda in 1920 and circulated among the natives had little or no effect. The phenomenon of 1920, when the Buganda growers saw that by taking their own action against the East of the Nile where open competition was still in force, they could secure a price average of 100 shillings higher per hundred pounds than was being offered by the buying associations within Buganda, had a new, healthy effect on them. It seemed to make the idea of a union of the native population was not likely to be dispelled by the ginners or by the Government and that the existing combination would be dissolved. It seemed desirable that recommendations in this regard should be made by the Chairman of the Uganda Cotton Association in securing a Uganda of such ability in the present and the future as to secure such universal recognition immediately as the Meru Center.

THE MEALY-BUG MENACE IN KENYA.

(Continued from page 5.) By banding the trees with some kind of repellent substance... A considerable amount of work remains to be done on various species of such pestiferous insects...

Use of Banding. Before describing types of bands in package advance it should be pointed out that the operation is best performed... There are two parts of plantation, or open wood plantations, which are most liable to be attacked by the pest...

Types of Banding. There are two kinds of insecticide bands which may be used... As applied on trees of somewhat open growth-pattern a paste of paper and the paper comes in contact with the insect...

It is found that the most effective repellent is the one which contains the most active ingredients... The time of banding is all important and it should always be undertaken before the main flowering appears.

The date will only become definite when conditions such as the weather and the stage of the crop are taken into consideration... It is assumed that banding should be done as early as possible in the district.

There is a difference of opinion as to whether it is more advisable to save the short rain harvest, or to wait until the long rain has set in... It is assumed that banding should be done as early as possible in the district.

Banding may be continuous throughout the year if it may be maintained in effectiveness for one or two or five or ten months... The extent of the application of repellent should be sufficient to cover the trees for several years...

The Native and the Law. Public interest has been created by the retrial in the High Court of Kenya of four natives charged with the murder of another African sixteen months ago on a farm near Kisumu. After a first hearing, the natives were condemned to death. They would have been executed but for the energetic intervention of a Kenya lawyer, Mr. Oswald Bentley, their lawyer. Not without great difficulty, as a lawyer, Mr. Bentley caused the case to be brought before the Appeal Court of East Africa and he was able as a result of personal investigation and his intimate knowledge of all the parties concerned, to convince the Appeal Court that grounds existed for reconsideration. The result of the retrial has been the acquittal of four men who were, at one time, within four days of death—condemned by the law of the country after the whole of judicial machinery had been in operation. The Colony will acquiesce in Mr. Bentley's action. His timely and determined attitude in the whole case and his justified suspicion of his heads has been a triumph for himself and the principles for which he stood in his successful endeavor to prevent the execution of an instrument for the apprehension of truth.
