**THE POULTRY WORLD.**

**THE HATCHING SEASON.**

Exceptionally Good Year.

From all reports, that has been an exceptionally good hatching season. Eggs have proved plentiful, and have hatched strong healthy chickens. Personally, I have had two to three hundred and fifty chicks from one hen, and I have had many more from other flocks. There was a good few losses due to the heavy rain, but otherwise there has been very little mortality.

We have been inoculating for chicken pox at about five to seven weeks old, it has proved very successful. The last lot, about sixty, that I did, have received chicken pox, but only very slightly. I do not know whether it was the fault of the vaccine or whether the chicks were already infected before inoculation. I have given up all idea of getting the place free from chicken pox and shall continue to inoculate all youngsters. It is very little trouble to do and it has really proved a preventive of the disease. I have recently given vaccine to the chickens. It has come to the conclusion that what "one" has cured, must be continued. But if the infection comes he got rid of, still there is no reason to sit down and see what the chickens with their eyes closed up, feathers ruffled, and altogether a horrible sight, when the very small trouble of inoculation will greatly minimize the risk.

However, as regards to hatching. The tendency is, when eggs are placed in the incubator, to have the brooder in the country to continue hatching, without stopping to change the brooder, and the short runs coming along. As far as I am concerned, my incubator goes out of commission in the middle of October until December. What little hatching I do after that will be by hen only. It is altogether too much joy getting several of small chickens into stable every time it rains, and raising them out again when the sun comes out. Provided there is plenty of shelter available, most hens have sufficient intelligence to take their broods into it, but chickens "on their own" seem to rush to every part of the compass except that in which the house is situated.

Then there is the little matter of accommodation. It is a very pretty sight to see numbers of little baby chicks running about, and it is a pity to find them in the little balls of dust, and give them plenty of attention. It is often a very different matter when they

become leggy, and seem to favour one side of the body when to get well grown, adult stock, the chicks receive the most attention. Many people do not realize that a thirty or so baby chicks will not grow up to be a good stocker at six weeks old. The under-used parent is often the cause of the trouble, for when we see, very often in the case of a young stocker, that it lacks of good attention while growing.

I always think ahead during hatching operations, and wonder whether the growing stock is going to be housed. It is better to sell off all the young stock, for which you have no sufficient accommodation, at a small price, than risk the quality of your future breeding stock by overcrowding. I know that, in the poultry farmer's view, it is the best way to part with your youngsters before they are old enough to show their quality, and it is a young feeling to feel later on that you have parted with potential prize winners and retained a number of "runners".

From the time the chicks leave the hen one can make a rough guess as to which chicks are going to have the best opportunities, by means of the marks which are always well to the fore when the food brought in first, and the cockbirds who are always ready for a scrap, and, unless one is a very experienced breeder, it is impossible to select the best birds for points in plumage and type. However, as three months old one can certainly give one a good few "runners" from a large flock, and from that time onwards each month further culling can be done. Rhode Islands always give me the most trouble in culling. It is marvellous the difference between, say, a cockbird of four months old and the same bird at six months, but as far as plumage is concerned, I do not like to see a leggy, capably looking thing, often with white in the plumage, but when he is six months he may be a beautiful red rump and a handsome fellow altogether.

Then with the pullets (the pullets which are going to develop into a fine well built hen is often all legs which seem as if they do not really belong to her, she will often have one solitary dark feather sticking up in her tail, and a body which

INDIVIDUALITY IN CAR DESIGN

The Tendency in Europe.

AMERICA UNWARY BY TRADITION

One of the most interesting points to anyone who has had any experience of the motor industry is the gradual evolution of the modern car from the earliest known vehicles emanating from a given manufacturer.

Just 14-horse six-cylinder as low as a racing machine, with nearly the racing machine's performance for its size, and throughout it still retains the suggestion of the original Alfa Romeo of years ago.

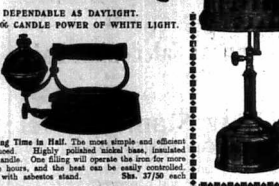

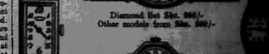

Entomologist Explains Banding Processes.

Dr. H. C. Janse, Ph.D., B.Sc., M.D.A., M.D., of the Government Entomologist who is at charge of the campaign against Mealy-bug, explains the banding processes of the insect. It deals with the limitations of spraying and the use of insecticides.

strips of American painted wood... The most successful method has been found to be by banding the trees with some kind of repellent substance.

Banding Repellent.

Since no repellent substance has yet been discovered which has no deleterious effect on the tree, the repellent should be applied direct to the bark, the latter has to be protected by means of green proof paper and cotton wool.

High Binding Point.

The green proof paper is then wrapped over the middle with string (Fig. 1.B.). Care should be taken to see that the string is tensioned sufficiently tight to keep the band in position.
