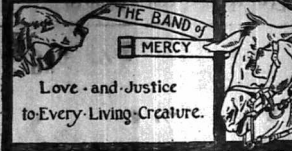

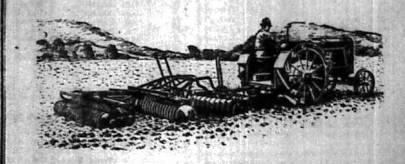

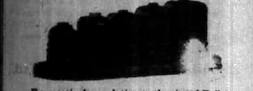

## THE MODERN LIGHT CAR.

Nothing Friskish About 1930 Model.

### POINTS WHICH THEY EXCORPORATE.

(Continued.)  
In the early days of light cars, engines were not nearly so efficient as they are nowadays; as a result, the remarkable fuel-economy feature of modern light-car engines which we know now was unheard of, for we use far less fuel for the same job. In the days immediately following the war, however, the small high efficiency four-cylinder engine made extraordinary strides, and it was found that without requiring a light car of the performance the bodywork and the general fitting-up could be far more elaborate.

Today we have reached a stage when, as we have already pointed out, compression, compressibility, surprisingly easy and efficient methods have been found to be fitted to chassis with engine output well within the light-car category. There is just one other aspect of the question which is worthy of

comment. The man who sets out to design, make and market a light car knows that he will have to live up to ideals which do not greatly concern people who are content with the production of a car for the million. It is the quality of design and construction in a car having an output of just over 1,000 c.w. that is not accepted as a light car. It is not ordinary run-in, but a perfectly fast and unimpeded roadstead strictly in accordance with the light car to those who understand with a simple definition.

From time to time the wisdom of adhering to this original limit has been questioned. After all, a considerable amount of science has to be brought to bear on the problem of production of a light car. It is worth that weight must be kept within certain limits, and that engine efficiency must be studied in every detail. However, the price consideration has to be taken into account.

### Policy with Fuel-Bearing Parts.

It is the policy which a determined light-car policy has had upon the industry of late is very considerable. Much of the efficiency of modern light cars has been due to the results of better bearings in relation to gear assembly associated with lighter design. As a result, the use of modern rollers might well be

fitted with the slow-rotating and comparatively low efficiency engines of the past. In those days, apart from the size, overall dimensions and weight, is there a marked difference in running costs between the light car and the heavy car? That is the question which we must immediately to the lips of any person of an inquiring turn of mind. The answer is, of course, emphatically, "Yes." The average annual fuel payable on a light car is about £10, as compared with anything from £12 to £15 on the case of one which see just outside the light-car class.

Let us also be reminded by the lowest premiums which it costs to insure, whilst actual running costs represented by the consumption of petrol and oil are very much less.

The most modern light car will now run 80 miles on a gallon of petrol, the more economical light car is frequently only 50 miles to the gallon. On all occasions are equally economical, whilst when it comes to tyre life, the latter is obvious, for the tyres themselves, being smaller, cost far less to replace. There is also a big saving on the maintenance side. Any enthusiast and intelligible owner can remove the head of a side-valve light-car engine, disassemble it and grind in the valves, but it


case of a larger car this might well be beyond his capabilities. It is the fact that a car which is sufficiently clever to carry out the work of a service station will do the job for him, showing in adjustment to the magnitude and clearing the customer for 50s. or so. Should replacement be necessary at any time they are, obviously, cheaper than new.

Here it would, perhaps, be appropriate to mention that it is not the maximum speed accepted as being the maximum for any reasonable car, but the maximum speed and acceleration combined and averaged over the period of about 1,000 per annum. So-called "hot" cars may be fast on an even lower figure. Proof of this road-worthiness reliability is provided by the increasing numbers which are appearing on our roads.

attention has been given to electric wiring, the number of hydrants necessary for the district was increased, the duty of controlling the hydrants was delegated to a special officer and important additions have been made to the Brigade. ## A GREAT LITTLE FIGHTER

### Tragic Death of Johnny Hill

HIS RISE TO FAME.

(‘WARDAW’ CORRESPONDENT.)  
 London, October 5.  
 The announcement of the tragic death of Johnny Hill came as a bombshell to the boxing world. Hill, who would have been 24 on December 14, was losing his preliminary training at home, under the direction of his father, his only tutor and trainer. He caught a chill last week-end, and on Monday ceased work and sought medical advice. He was, apparently, making excellent progress, as the doctor permitted him to leave his bed on Thursday, and it was expected that he would resume training next week. During the night, however, Hill suddenly became unconscious and burst a blood vessel in the lung, dying shortly afterwards. His father was surprised as every-body else and is incredulous.

Young Hill first boxed in London early in 1920, when as an amateur he won the A.B.A. fly weight title at the Albert Hall, knocking out H. A. Warwick the three times holder, in the final. In the same year he became professional, and in 1927, after Elky Clark had had to relinquish the title through injury to his eye, received the world's title fight with Pulei Ia. He took the championship and held it by beating Al. Harbo, the Brighton ex-amateur in 14 rounds. After winning the British title and stopping the two best little Continental fighters, Morawchik and Fritz Ruppert, Hill was matched with Emil Pfleger for the European fly weight championship. The great fight between these two on December 1st, 1927, and again on March 19, the following year will be ever remembered by only at the National Sporting Club. Hill won both contests, but only by a small

margin of points, after being put down for occasions in each. When his fight on August 29 last year as the Clapton contender which he lost Newbury Rivers, from New York, for the world championship of the world. Hill went to fight for his life on the third time on February 7, but in a contest to win a long time he fought at the little foot was knocked out in the sixth round. It will be not actually a dish name to dull and fatious, and another cause for the next time; it is probable that he has not been really good for a long time, he certainly did not show up as the old Johnny Hill of the past. It was thought by many people that Grealy would not be allowed to land, but he did land, and a meeting of the Ministry of Labour stated that they had an arrangement with the B.B.C.C., but they granted permits on their own responsibility although they used the Board as a source of advice. The news of Hill's death came as a last rebuke to Hill by attending the funeral which took place on Tuesday at Streatham. 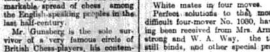

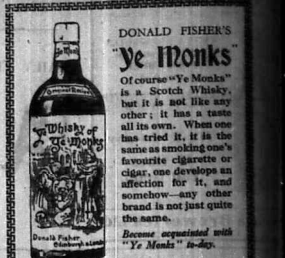

### THE POULTRY WORLD.

## REARING OF GEES.

### Hints to the Farmer.

Geese are very hardy and resistant to anything, but the disease is necessary for them. They feed the ground to keep it in a healthy state, and they will also be very expensive to feed. It is not advised to keep them, but to take advantage of the fact that they can be raised on what cattle loss to feed for one thing the geese will quickly graze of the land, of the pasture, and another thing cattle do not like grazing after them. People who have ground under grain should certainly keep a few of geese, as once the crop is in, the geese will feed themselves on the stubble, while until the land is put under the plough again. This will carry the geese over the dry part of the year when there is not much to graze elsewhere. Geese must be kept in a dry place, and their big bills and water holes some material that will drain away as they make rather a mess of the house. Housing should be kept without water except for drinking but they will thrive better if they have it.

Geese are essentially water birds, therefore it is necessary to have big fenced ponds, and preferably a quick growing breed. The best birds are the Toulouse and Embden. A cross between the two will give good table birds.  
It is not usual to allow the geese to sit on a few first clutch of eggs, if these are removed early, they that they are laid, she is not likely to go broody and will soon start laying again. If the eggs are laid in the nest she will go broody as soon as she has finished the clutch.  
Geese egg vary in the time they take to hatch. The incubation period is supposed to be thirty days but I find they usually hatch out on the twenty-ninth or thirtieth day. Chicks are very hardy and they can be reared in the same manner as other water fowl. It is not well to keep them from swimming water, and long grass until they get their feathers as they may get chilled and drowned.  
If the eggs are hatched out

under the goose it is best to leave her alone until she begins to peck the goslings out into the open. She will probably scrub some of the goslings, but it is necessary to remove them the first day, while the goslings are moved to their new quarters.  
I have often been told that it is necessary to keep the gander away from the goslings or he will kill them. My experience is that the gander is just as kind to the youngsters as the geese and is usually pretty hard on them, but all and usually that comes too near the brood.

### DAILY FERTISING-WHY NOT?

Contrary to an oft-repeated opinion, early planting is not the primary cause of crooked brassicas, and if the perch is of proper size and shape I do not see why it can affect the brassicas of the beds, however young the birds may be. Wrong methods of feeding and rearing have been much to blame for this trouble, but in the light of increased knowledge on both these subjects there is now better knowledge and less soil loss in our work. Allow the birds to perch as early as they desire to do so, and they will not crowd should a cold spell come. The perch must not be slender, and should be rounded off—see below. It is so that those resting are not stable whenever another bird flies up. Do not put the perch close to the roof, and let there be space for all the birds to perch in comfort. Incidentally, perches should be movable, so that they can be "rotated" from time to time with tarps to keep pests from taking them. (R.E. Smith in the "Poultry World".)

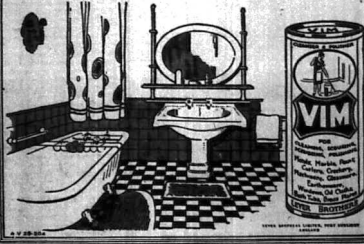

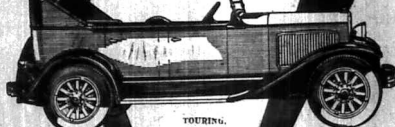

## WHAT 1930 CARS INCORPORATE

Many Improvements in Bodywork.

### OUTSTANDING TRENDS

The following article, giving in detail the trend of development in 1930 cars is found incorporated in 1933 cars as well as the "Autocar". For a long time automotive bodywork was regarded as being of relatively little importance in comparison with the chassis, but now, owing to the mechanical part of modern cars, has progressed so far towards complete reliability that the actual changes which are made tend to become concentrated on the chassis and general appearance. Naturally, one performance is improved year by year by various changes in engine design, suspension, steering, brakes, and so forth, but these modifications are not of a kind to be immediately obvious to the layman. Consequently, a 1929-type touring car with its same engine of 1930 type would be indistinguishable, externally, to show the difference. As a result, it is in the bodywork that we find the most striking changes revealed.

### Wealth of Body Style

It is difficult to generalize because there is such a wealth of styles and types of body available, but nevertheless, some definite trends are clearly visible. One is the widespread use of more rounded and pleasing surfaces, in order to obtain a grade in appearance very different from the sharpness of the box-like forms which were common only a few years ago.

Apart from the matter of appearance, this arrangement has a practical value in that slanting glass reflects a portion of the rays from street lamps or head lights to the eyes of the occupants of the car.

### Valance Less Popular

A second outstanding feature in 1930 cars is the general practice of providing a particularly large front door, and also an extending downward slope from the running boards, and a new form of door, known as a "step-down" door, which is much more convenient in the sense of producing a clean surface, and no one will regret the passing of the Chevrolet valance, with its easily scratched surface, and its tendency to dent or warp.

Deep body sides and narrow windows result in a real big car, a sense of better handling (or at least a break up these surfaces, a belt, or a strap, is used before the windows, pushed out in a contrasting color. Previous styles of this kind were seldom immediately very popular. Another form of decoration which has been introduced consists of heading which has been chrome plated and its therefore, unobtainable and which may be used to emphasize a waist line, a swift joint or some similar detail.

The general adoption of body sides deeper, height of the frame has left the designer free to create wide bodies from before, built well out over the rear wings, so as to provide a more commodious floor on a very neat.

Smooth external surfaces are, indeed, a general feature; for example, the front fenders are now enclosed by a curved apron of sheet metal, and the hood is covered by the radiator, and continues around the front of the car. The same idea is noticeable in the hood and fender aprons, which is almost everywhere employed to enclose the tank.

### Improved Legroom Accommodation

The convenience of many people who use cars for week-end and holiday touring, has been justly studied so that the car of 1930 abounds in handy accommodations such as shelves, rubber floor, door pockets and parcel racks, in which miscellaneous such as gloves, scarves and maps can quickly be stowed away. Then there are the many models available in which a large saddle seat is provided, and the passenger is seated in a high, comfortable position, which represents a big advance over the old method of stepping luggage to a grid. There is no doubt, also, that such trends improve the appearance of a car viewed from the back.

The front view of most 1930 cars has been made more attractive by employing a tall, comparatively narrow rectangular radiator with slanted top edges, from them were formerly fashioned. The radiator is commonly extended downwards between the side members of the frame so as to give a lower appearance to the car as a whole. Chromium plating has become almost universal for the front of external height parts such as radiators, lamps, windscreen frames, etc., and the radiator is being extended laterally beyond the front of the car to give a sleeker appearance by wiping the surface with a deep cleft.

### Unplasterable Glass Almost Entirely

Next must be mentioned the widespread use of unpolished, leaded glass in 1930 models, offered as a standard fitting, but at any rate obtainable for but a slight increase in cost. The material, as is well known, is more difficult to clean and is more prone to be scratched than ordinary clear glass. As regards bodywork, interior upholstery is generally

noticeable, with an increase in the use of pneumatic cushions. New materials have also been employed of which the Rayon cloth, evolved by Courtauld, is a case in point. This is a synthetic fabric which is light weight, and is said to be as soft as the finest wool. The same idea is noticeable in the seat fabric, but the upholstery except drive the car.

### The Open-Air Body

Type of bodywork which is particularly popular for each class at medium and low prices are the straight, four-door coupe, the two-door sportsman's coupe, with emergency non-enclosed insulation for two persons in addition to the driver and front-seat passenger, and the open touring car which is still dominant. The list of open-air bodies of some type in their range of models, the most popular, perhaps, being that in which the front part is a permanent part of the body, and the rear part is a separate, additionally, many incorporate features which practically shield the whole of the roof can be hidden off the way.

Turning to the mechanical part of the car, the outstanding features for 1930 are a better performance, much easier maintenance, and an increased use of multi-cylinder engines, both "six" and "eight". The six-cylinder type of car has been kept up the rapid growth, and increase in its numbers which has been available at very low prices. For 1930 there are more than half a dozen six-cylinder cars by British, Continental and American makers, selling complete for less than £200, a still larger number, rated at about 10 h.p., is available within a price limit of £60, and above this limit, up to 25 h.p., cars of moderate performance which make ideal powerful engines. In the 20 h.p. class the "straight-eight" is beginning to compete with the "six," and, indeed, there is a British example obtainable at about £400. In this way, by concentrating upon multi-cylinder design, manufacturers are providing the vehicle with cars of exceptional flexibility, liveliness and endurance.
