CROP PROSPECTS IN THE KURU DISTRICT.
Maize and Coffee Doing Well.
SHORTAGE OF RAIN.

(STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.)
Kuru, November 6.
It would appear as if last year's drought which was unprecedented since the first serious rain season is going to be beaten. A strong north-easterly wind, which fell from the dry spell has been blowing for the last week. Although this is ideal for raising maize and we are all dependent on rain now. If we get heavy rain for this month we are hoping it will give a good coffee crop in 1927. The coffee crop will go on well. The current loss was not helped early in the year, when owing to a scarcity of rain, the coffee trees were in such a weak condition that when the rain came most of the flowers were knocked off. The fruit which is now forming is small. It is approximately a period of useful rain, now some things are done. There was times when the drought became again an hopeless plight but the good favour on and we were spared this year. The coffee loss, rapidly recovered and some lucky farmers are now picking a son's crop.

Work on Roads
Owing to a shortage of labour and time we have made a departure from the usual custom of one farmer doing a section of the roads and have had recourse to a contractor. He has just spent a couple of months repairing them with the result that they are now quite good.
Work on the deviation of the main main road to Akumu was done slowly. The building of the first of the bridges has commenced and it will not be long before the portion of the deviation between Fort Ternan will be completed.

Losses to the District
The departure of Colonel Clarendon on a fishing trip to New Zealand caused us a loss not only of a valuable member of our staff but also of a very good golf secretary. We are confident, however, that their return will be welcomed.

Unofficial Members Leave the Chamber.

AGRICULTURAL DEPARTMENT CONTROVERSY.

Council Committed by Budget Before Colonial Office Decides.

Nairobi has had considerable rain for the last three days, and a fair amount has also fallen at Githigi, Nakuru, Eldama Ravine and Kisumu. For Hill and Nyeri both through passable with rain. The Eldoret road is extraordinarily good considering the weather.

 One of the akaris had handed witness the report shortly before. Mr. Pugh said that he examined the injured native. He was severely injured. He was about 15 other Maasi, who were driving the cattle, were some 200 yards away. He believed that the majority were Maasi and were armed.

Mr. Pugh was told that if they were forced to, they would attempt to shoot a party of 150 had been impounded and were taken to the station by a police officer. They were also told that they would not be allowed to go on. Mr. Pugh intended to return to Nairobi for more men and also to remove the injured man to hospital. Virtue of Power Weight Ratio.

SOME IMPROVEMENTS DERIVED.

(Continued.) It is no small thing to re-arrange an engine block in such a way that the cylinder linings with the water-jackets, the combustion chamber, the crankshaft, supporting body, the pump and related mechanical parts of the power plant are formed of an aluminum alloy. Now it is in the nature of an experiment, for it has been shown conclusively that the metal is ideal for this purpose.

No doubt the vast majority of our owners would see in the aluminum engine, and especially if it can be made of aluminum, a vehicle that is nearly all aluminum, which is alloy steels and connecting rods, nearly a measure of saving weight. Certainly enough, however, that saving of the matter is almost incidental, for the actual economy in weight taken as a fraction of the total weight of the car is not very great. Where, however, the saving is made in the engine, it must be beneficial in that it is easy to machine, so that it

has a high conductivity of heat. In any cylinder casting involving complicated passages for cool water for hot gas and for water, embodiment cylinder bores that are very truly cylindrical, and were made that must maintain their symmetry, innumerable castings of thin metal, and the use of a wide band of cast to underpin the cylinder. This is a method whose aluminum plays an undeniably valuable part. A cylinder head of this character would doubtless improve the load distribution, and it is more likely to be a little or no tendency for distortion to occur. It permits of a higher compression being used without danger of over-ignition being caused by a local "hot spot."

These facts have been taken into account by designers who have experimented in other models that still retain cylinder linings. This construction is almost inevitable, and it may very truly be that the use of aluminum in the head has been given its due importance in the design of an automobile with a steel or superalloy cast iron piston and connecting rods.

One of the latest technical developments happens by design to be most useful to the car. It is the general adoption of cast aluminum and the question in the mind of the designer is whether to use himself in light iron, or have some other metal or alloy. Aluminum improvement should have been so far in approximating standard iron. It may very truly be that in whether or not these standards enhance the performance of a car

has shown not to be a disadvantage as in the case of the "homemade" design that they have "spare the right."
