CIVILIZATION TEST FOR THE FRANCHISE.

Common Roll Issue Being Forced.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

Views Urged by Aborigines Protection Society.

The issue of the Common Roll and the universal Civilization Test for all races in East Africa is being forced to the front in Britain.

It is stressed as the central feature of the situation in a Memorandum headed by the Aborigines Protection Society to the Secretary of State.

The Memorandum deals with forced labor, equitable taxation and land reservation for Natives as subordinate questions which should be included in any declaration by the Imperial Government.

China Appeals to Other Powers.

VIOLATION OF PEACE PACT.

Nanking, November 26.

The Chinese Central Government has addressed an appeal to the League of Nations and to individual signatories of the Kellogg Pact to take steps to stop and punish the Soviet "invasion" of Chinese territory, as a deliberate violation of the Pact.

The delegation declares that while the National Government has always remained on the defensive despite repeated attacks, the Soviet, without declaration of war, organized Chinese armies and "suddenly" massed some 100,000 Chinese troops.

Tsao to be burned.

A message from Harbin states that the Chinese authorities have ordered the towns of Heiliao to be burned in order to prevent it falling into the hands of Soviet troops.

The matter grows now on fire. The Chinese authorities have ordered the military situation at Harbin to cease, in the evacuation of all Americans from the town.

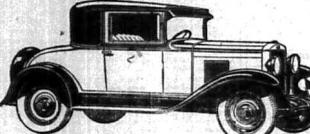

HEAVY RAINS IN NANYUKI DISTRICT.

Roads in Impassable Condition. FAMINE RELIEF AT NERU.

STARRS' CORRESPONDENT.

Nanyuki, November 28. The November rains are now in full swing. Rivers are in spate and roads almost impassable. The Nanyuki river rose over six feet on Saturday evening, covering the main road at the bridge for several distances. Mr. Malin's smithy was completely under water and the water wheel, situated on the main river, washed away. Although completely submerged, though, the mill continues to work, having been bogged in a late rain river. Every year the rains cause about that between October 24 and December 14 roads are impassable, so that the high rate of \$10.147 per bag of maize for the 74 miles, now being paid by Government, does not cover transport expense, and many truck-owners are giving it up.

The death toll among the tribes beyond Mera towards the Tana River is said to be approaching 200 a month already, and this unless the roads dry up which is unlikely there is apt to be a considerably higher mortality in the starvation area.

Miss Spryer's landing of her plane was much admired by her pupils and it is noteworthy that Mrs. Lysons, who had never at her own request on both sides and from Mera drill, the party landed on the Riverside Road, subsequently filled up with petrol and in spite of a very heavy rainstorm over Gode's plains, were back at Mera well before sunset. Capt. Grant explained that these flying lessons (as they otherwise in Rhodesia) belonged to National Flying Training Camp, a station on a commercial road between the river and Mera.

Mr. Shaw and Mr. Marshall were in Nanyuki on Thursday, the former (who is the contractor) being most optimistic as regards the arrival of the railway exactly in Nanyuki in three months time. Work on line that is now in place has a fine view of the river stock in the small moment, thus in excellent news indeed.

Next month it is hoped that the truncated road will be completed from Nanyuki and railroad from the moment. Due to transport difficulties, Nanyuki is almost cut off from Mombasa.

Full Development of Political Institutions Among Natives.

Speaking of the child psychology of the African he declares that a childlike human cannot be a bad human—but the child mortality provides no inward impetus to improvement.

The Native Policy he considers suitable for Africa is one that will not force the institutions and culture of the Native into European moulds but preserve that which is precious in the African culture and build their civilisation on specifically African foundations.

African policies should arise, he declares, in Africa from the experience of men and women who are in daily contact with its living problems.

It urges the importance of a system of individual land tenure, emphasising the devastating effects of the communal system apparent in the degeneration of native reserves.

As favours as the only real basis of policy separate but parallel political institutions for the African as well as separate residential areas. It indorses the fact that the colour bar is impracticable and objectionable to the modern conscience.

Denouncing how far this political segregation can be carried, he limits the application of Cecil Rhodes' dictum of equal rights for all citizens as being restricted to a time when the only place for civilised Nations' that is, changed.

He therefore believes that although the Native should be encouraged to develop self-governing institutions in his own life, white and black must be represented together on the supreme legislative body on a basis of equal representation of mixed constituencies. In other words each should represent only his own people.

General Smuts condemns the squatter system. He declares that the removal of native families from the tribal areas as leading to the despatchment which has created most of the political difficulties in Africa.

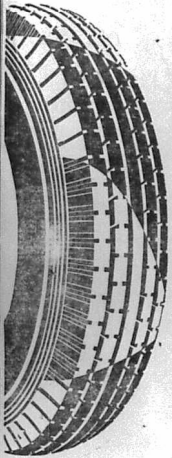

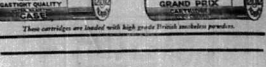
