MESSAGE FROM THE GOVERNOR.

New Colony May Help to Increase Settlement.

The need for a spirit of tolerance in Kenya was the keynote of the gala speeches at the Caledonian Society's Annual Dinner in Nairobi on Saturday when Mr. James McCrea, of Nairobi, proposed the toast of 'Let Land We Live In.'

Speaking to the absence of His Excellency the Governor, the reply was in the hands of the Colonial Secretary.

Mr. Moore read a letter from Sir Edward Grigg expressing the sentiments of Mr. McCrea's speech. The speaker promised that statements of Chief Magistrates would be made when Legislative Council resumes. He expressed the possibility of the Colony sending the settlement movement by giving help from the country's funds.

Mr. Edward also indicated the improbability that he would consider an extension of his present tour, although he expressed the wish to visit the highlands in the event of establishing a 'Glorious Union' owing to the delay in the highlands.
