AGRICULTURAL SHOW AT NAKURU.

(Continued from page 1.)
The Trade Exhibitors, for on this occasion, show will not be confined to one arena, as was common before the war. These arrangements were made for the staging of the District Exhibits and the produce classes.

General Improvements.
Perhaps the most striking feature which I noticed was the very greatly improved appearance of the Show Ground itself. An enormous amount of work has been done since the last Show was held in Nakuru. Climate conditions in recent months have favoured the promoters of the Show and the grounds themselves are looking at the very best. The trees which surrounded the ring have been cut and provide welcome shade in the heat of the day.
The ring itself is looking beautifully green, and is surrounded by white-painted railings. Multi-colored flags, which are so very pleasing everywhere, give a festive touch.

Livestock Accommodation.
All of the stands in which produce and other competitive classes will be staged have been improved and are of a more permanent nature than has been the case hitherto. The horse boxes and cattle sheds have also undergone improvement, and are today looking very nice and spick, having received a new coat of white paint.

The pig and sheep pens have been cleaned off all recognition with the aid of the gun.
Dogs and poultry will be housed under good conditions which should meet with general approval.
At an Agricultural Show one of the most interesting of the classes is that in which the different districts compete. On this occasion there will be no fewer than eight districts represented in competition for the perpetual Challenge Cup presented by Major General Sir Edward Northey. These districts will be Fort Ternu, Nandi, Elgon, and Upper Kericho, Bungai and Lower Main, Baki, Bropker, Thomson's Falls and Subulbi. The cup has been competed for on an occasional previous year, being won twice by Nakuru, twice by Lamuria, once by the Trans Nile and on the last occasion (December 1920) by Thomson's Falls.

Remarkably Good Exhibits.

In the other classes the number of entries has been wonderfully large. In fact the Nakuru Show has become famous for the amount of work that has been exhibited and it seems that this reputation will be maintained for as the entries in all the horse classes are very good indeed. The same may also be said of the poultry classes. The Pans Produce classes have been well supported, maize and coffee being particularly strong.

Staging of Retail Exhibits.
As an example of the way in which conditions are better improved at East African Shows the method of staging the better exhibits at Nakuru may be quoted. It is not many years ago that the butter used to be staged, along with other exhibits, on benches made of bamboo in sheds that were hot. The natural result was that those people who came to the show on the second day found that the butter had melted into an unattractive looking mass. Even at some of the larger Shows at Nakuru the butter has often melted considerably from the heat.

At Nakuru, this year, the butter will be shown in the same manner as it is exhibited at the Royal Show in England. Cases have been constructed with glass lined tops. At the back of the case is a narrow channel in which ice will be kept at all times. The butter will be kept in bags and, and free from dust and bad wind. The cases have been constructed by the Anglo Timber Company, and were the first of their kind ever to be used in East Africa. This is typical of the many ways in which an endeavour is all the time being made to provide the conditions for exhibitors.

The Commercial Houses.
The Show has been remarkably well supported by the commercial people of Nakuru. In spite of having paid a considerable amount of great difficulty and hard-

ship, they have come forward determined to make the Show a big success. Today every one of the stands are well advanced and series are continually arriving with more things of all sorts. The number of people who are exhibiting is the largest of the exhibits of the displays of Messrs C. J. Manser & Sons, Mr. Manser Gidley and Roberts, Hughes and Hutchinson, Elton & Co., and the Kenialla Estate.

The last of these in addition to a large stand on one side of the Show Ground, have also an interesting exhibit near the entrance. This is a complete four berth motor type, one horse and dairy, fitted up with modern mechanical milking machinery. The specifications and arrangement of this dairy have been approved by the Institute of Dairy Farmers of Great Britain and present several novel features as far as Kenya is concerned.

Another striking trade exhibit is that staged by C. Buser and Co., which consists of a little village of wooden houses of all sorts and descriptions suitable for farm use. There is every type of the smaller wooden building that can be imagined from a dog kennel upwards!

Convenience of Visitors.
The convenience of visitors to the Show has been thought of in many ways. There will be loud speakers so that all may hear the speeches. There is a delightful camping ground situated adjacent to the Show Ground, with water and firewood available, excellent shade, and the necessary conveniences which will be in the capable hands of the Nakuru Hotel, all over the Show Ground at various convenient spots there are shade trees which supply water, and a greatly improved view itself will make it easier to follow the various events of the day.

There are evidences on every hand that the Nakuru Show Committee have been hard at work for many months in their determination to make this Show the best which has ever been staged in the district. Mr. Murray Hill, the Secretary of the Society and Mrs. Hill, are hard at work putting the finishing touches. They have been greatly assisted in all their work by Mr. W. A. McFarland and Mrs. M. C. Purcell.

From every point of view it would seem certain that the Show this week will set a new standard for agricultural shows outside Nakuru. The week is cooler than is usual at this time of the year at Nakuru, and the weather has been shown each day lately.

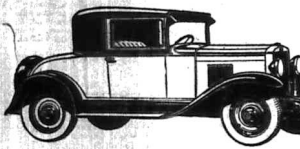

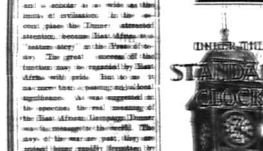

"The principle, which does not apply to other communities, is regarded as unjustifiable."

Mr. O'Shea, referring to Closer Union, supported the Wilson Report principles as the limit of the Elected Members attempt to secure agreement and added that if a settlement was attempted in the atmosphere reflected by present Home controversy it would be a complete failure.

Mr. O'Shea condemned the present system of government in the Colony as out-of-date and regarded change as inevitable. "Reform was essential to the progress of the Colony."

He also declared that in his opinion Kenya is not an over-taxed country.

The speaker called for a progressive white settlement policy.

EDITOR'S NOTE.

A few weeks ago I gave the following remedy for blisters on the knees. It had been used most successfully by a firm of home growers in England. I was told tentatively by a lady who had tried it that the mixture had proved so efficacious for her two. On the advice of an expert in Chemistry, amounts on washing soda should be used. The reason being that water in this country is rather than in England, also owing to the dearth of soda the water would dry up much more quickly. Magdoli Soda may be used in the same quantity.

The original prescription was two ounces of ordinary washing soda to one gallon of water. Add two ounces of soft soap (to make it adhere better). When spraying is a preventive remedy. Because it is so simple you may doubt its efficacy, but try it and see.

THE PLANT'S BANNER.

The following article by Gilbert B. Hunter is reprinted with acknowledgments to that excellent journal "South African Gardening and Country Life."

As soon as the word banner is mentioned most people will think of a flag, a pennant, or a pennon, but here we mean to deal with another kind of banner, the soil. The soil has a considerable reserve of plant food, which, although not immediately available, can become available by the plants, thanks to the various fermentations and decompositions which take place in this underworld.

At the beginning of the 19th century the "classic" fondled to examine for himself the question of the soil's fertility, and in doing

so did the farmer with scientific suggestions. Unfortunately he tried to treat the soil as a mere inert thing, whose problems could be worked out by the application of fertilizers. He assumed that all there was to do was to analyze the soil and the crops and to work out how much of each ingredient fertilizer, phosphate, acid and so on, probably would have to be returned to the soil each year. But somehow the fertilizer thus discovered did not do in the form of practical agriculture, who because of this failure to treat the whole research as a whole.

The original going deeper also the matter of soil, and in fact the soil with suitable dampness which brought any of the plants they would not reproduce or flower. These deficiencies must be realized that the soil was not a mere matter, but a living organism. This organism has a certain life of its own, with its own processes and functions which cannot be broken down as an organism with an organized being. The process of that life is decided to call it and the plants to live on, and the soil to be brought on the other. The farmer must not be misled with a complete variety of solids, liquids and gases. The study of the soil is not a matter simply because these elements did not leave any chemical laws then known.

The thought was found a difficulty was before him, for he had to deal with the invisible forces and factors of a new world.

At the present day we know that the soil is a mass of fine mineral matter derived from various kinds of rocks such as chalk, granite, sand, etc., mixed with the decomposing action of the natural elements of organic matter which occurs in the soil from the remains of previous generations of plants. Lastly, we have gases and water which circulate in the earth, thanks to its porosity.

As regards the growing of plants it has been discovered that the

soil must fulfil certain conditions as concerns the water supply, the supply of minerals, the temperature, water, soil and supply depend on the nature of the soil. For example, potatoes of the soil for a long night, steady rain, secure a better soil supply than a heavy frosty season. If the soil does not fulfil these conditions it can be flooded to a certain extent by the process of watering, drainage and so on, and some care by the addition of lime and fertilizer, or manure, with a good percentage of straw.

The soil contains, as has been said, a certain amount of plant food, but these are not directly taken up by the plants. They have first to be broken up into the smallest particles before becoming assimilable. The process is known as rotting, and the product, the liquid portion of a fertile soil is called humus. The micro-organisms which cause the rotting, and also by the slow oxidation of sulphur, they are said to liberate some of the elements that 1000 parts of our bodies are composed of it.

Despite the work of these micro-organisms being the quantities of the fine sand and pebbles, obtained from plants for a long period of time and therefore the cultivator must apply to the soil specially prepared fertilizers containing these elements, such as phosphate, potassium, etc.

In the study of the soil, however, science advances very slowly and there is still much to be learned, and it may be that in the next future we will know of the soil, the subject which may again modify all the views held at the present time.

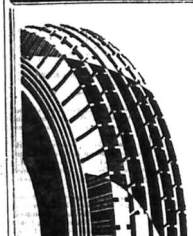

EDUCATING THE AFRICAN FOR DEMOCRACY.

Dr. Norman Leys and the Kenya Policy.

MUST BE CHANGED.

Dr. Norman Leys is still actively criticising the Kenya settler and the policy of the Colony. A lecture delivered by him at a meeting in the Manchester University, Kenya Colony, on the 19th inst., in which Professor Henry Clay presented is reported at column length in the Manchester Guardian.

Dr. Leys later also declared...

The first way of dealing with a country less civilized than our own is to govern it. Dr. Leys argues, as that advocated by the League against Imperialism, that of simple transfer of political and economic power from the European owners to the African workers. In his second way he spent a month in Africa, which he says that the Imperialists, who, rightly concluding that the Africans immediately to attempt democratic self-government would be madhouse, did not intend to enable Africans to remedy their impotency, and acted on the assumption that they were unfit to manage their own affairs without European supervision, but it was intended to treat them as people whose nature it was to be under authority for ever, so that it was criminal to teach them the things that made men want to be free. It was necessary to say that when we came across a nation or a tribe despotically governed we had no right to interfere. When circumstances would always to take the line of liberty.

The Alternative.

The real alternative in Africa was not between native and European authority, but between the native...

city of Europeans who governed in the interests of themselves and their friends and the authority of the African government and the interests of the natives. They had the worst results of all when... the Government was in theory governing in the interests of the natives, but in fact was under the control of these European employers.

He advocated the policy of education for democracy. This was in force, he was sorry to say, nowhere in Africa. The only agencies whose work was preparing the people for self-government was the Christian mission. Nationalism could be self-governing in ten years, but never than any other country in tropical Africa. The reason was that a kind of the children went to the schools of the European missions. Not in one of a hundred of the children were more than a beginning of this people would be made until the Africans made a noise in the world, and that would be dangerous, but it could not be helped. A. S. F. F.

The first necessary step was to carry out a change of policy. Dr. Leys said that the Government of Kenya spent over £400,000 a year on the education of each European child at school and less than 40 shillings on each African child. £15,000 Wanted to Complete the Building: A New Appeal.

The following new appeal has been received in respect of the Fund being raised by the people of the Highlands of the Colony at Harare to complete the Highlands Cathedral. The total required is £15,000 and it is hoped to make a start when £2,000 has been subscribed.



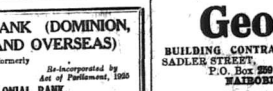
This shows what extent as done was £15,000. It was decided by the Synod that the building was to be the second Cathedral for the Diocese. The decision was approved by the Bishop.

Notes on the Building Scheme. When the first Bishop, James Hauntington, who was a member of the Diocese, was appointed in 1895, Harare was then a small town. Even in 1905 when the present Cathedral was projected, the influx of European settlers had hardly commenced and the work of the Church among the aboriginal tribes had only just begun in a very small way.

It is to be noted that the Bishop of Harare, the Archbishop of Capetown, and now after the Synod was constituted a Cathedral with all the responsibility for the building of the Cathedral.

In 1910 the western section of All Saints Church, Harare, was assigned to the architect, the late Mr. Temple Moore, and the actual drawings for the entire church are in our possession. The services of the church were to be devoted to the use of the traditional style of architecture. During the course of its construction it has been the object of many who on special occasions it has been the scene of many services, and the memorial on the wall has been to those who in the Great War and otherwise served our country well.

As the years passed, it became the feeling became strong that the building should be completed. The Church was founded for Harare, the Capital of the Colony and in 1920

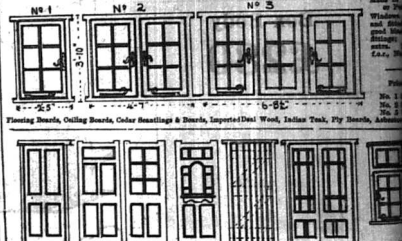

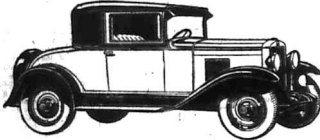

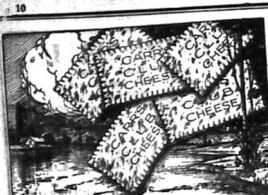
