FATAL ENDING TO THE LONDON-CAPE FLIGHT.

BOTH OFFICERS KILLED.

Unconfirmed Report by Native Tribemen.

The attempt by two officers of the Royal Air Force to make the world's non-stop flight record has apparently come to disaster. The last news of the aircraft was a wireless message stating that they were in the vicinity of Tunis. The Air Ministry made immediate investigations and learned that natives had seen a large aeroplane crash south of Tunis. Further reports from Tunis state that the aeroplane had come to rest 20 miles south of Tunis, and that the occupants were killed.

Financial Ministers suggested that the enquiry would be more effective if a person acquainted with modern business practices were associated with the office of administrative expenses in making the investigations.

Members also consider that the scope of an enquiry of this nature should probably be limited to the office of other Government Departments in which it is possible that the employment of more experienced officers might be of advantage and that the job being made of modern office appliances and in which it may therefore be found that economy is necessary and that it may be an alteration in system.
