and organisations under their
direct or indirect control including
the Russian Propaganda Society
and its branches in every part of
the Empire. It is also intended to
organise the collection of any
information which may be of value
to the British Government in
relation to the Russian Propaganda
Society and its branches in
any other countries.

It was further agreed, he added,
that efforts should be given to the
revelation of the above-mentioned
methods and their date on which
the respective Ambassadors pre-
sented their credentials.

Mr. Schröderhoff proceeds:
"Having this day presented to His
Royal Highness the Prince of
Wales his credentials as the
Ambassador of the Union of the
Royal Socialist Republics to His
Majesty the King, I have the
honour to be directed by the
People's Commissary for Foreign
Affairs and on behalf of the Gov-
ernment of Soviet Socialist Re-
publics to confirm the undertaking
contained in the articles quoted
above to inform you that the Gov-
ernment of the Union of the
Royal Socialist Republics regard
that undertaking as having the
force of a treaty between
themselves and Great Britain and
the Government of India. I am
instructed to add that the Gov-
ernment of the Union of the
Royal Socialist Republics will be happy
to receive in accordance with
Article 7 of the protocol of October
8, 1924, a corresponding declaration
from His Majesty's Government
in Great Britain and the Govern-
ment of India."

It will be recalled that during the Select Committee discussions of the 1935 Estimates, a promise was given by Government that an enquiry would be conducted into the housing policy, the terms of which would apply to enquiries of Government locally recruited, and the principles which would govern State aid to the cost of African hospitals run by private organizations.

Government has now implemented its promise and the details of the Committees of Enquiry are published to-day.

Investigation of the housing position in the main districts of the Colony will embrace consideration of whether Civil Servants should be invited to make their own housing arrangements.

An enquiry into the status of locally engaged officers covers the wider question of the institution of a local Civil Service.

KENNEL NOTES



Miss Collyer, slight in whom all correspondence in connection with **Kennel Notes** should be sent, does not accept any responsibility for accuracy of statements made by her which are, in the main, based on information supplied by her correspondents.

Dog ailments in this country are certainly very puzzling. The following are a few points. A young Areeda bitch of mine, whose high spirits make her difficult to control, was put to bed the other night perfectly well, having eaten a good supper. Next morning at 6:30 when I went to look her out of her house I found her completely foamed. She could not get on to her hind legs without assistance. Her nose and lips were hard and swollen and so was the old hind leg from the foot to the hock. She showed signs of considerable pain across her hock, but not the ordinary lameness of which one might have expected only so small oed and wet wounds. The white of her eye was very much congested. No temperature, respiration was slightly rapid, but I fancy more from fear than any other cause. Constipation was present. In discussing the evening leg I could get no story of acute pain, neither could I when manipulating the foot, muzzles, so the first sign of trouble was passed on to my mind. When left alone the bitch whined and grunted continually as though she was aching all over but not so as to get up. She was picked up and put on her hind legs. She crawled slowly. Her quarters gradually sinking till they rested on the point of her hocks. The hock were here very swollen and muscled very tense when stood up. There was a certain paralysis, though I ceased her to try. There was a certain partial paralysis though not complete. I may be a little on the wrong track but I think it was an acute form of horsemadness, a case of which I have never seen, or of dog before, but I have been up of notice to her hocks, and awaiting for the follow-up, the symptoms very much coincided with that of all I treat. I was put her on to a comfortable rest, but out of all draught, a level teaspoonful of

where she sleeps when loose I can't have.

The Native Population Kenya and Uganda Trade

INTERESTING FIGURES IN MONTHLY REPORT.

An analysis of native population showing the number of registered natives in employment during October, 1926, has been prepared by the Asst. Chief Registrar of Natives. Some extremely interesting figures are disclosed by this report.

The greatest percentage of able-bodied male natives reported in employment from any area is 78.65 from Kyambala district. The second highest figure is provided by the Mandi tribe who supply 67.60 per cent. Lamuria supply 67.10 per cent. Fort Hall 62.80 per cent, and North Kavirondo 62.72 per cent. The lowest percentage is supplied by the Northern Frontier Province which supplies only 42.

An increase of 285 natives employed in October, as compared with September is reported from the Fort Hill area. There is an increase of 193 from North Kavirondo, 135 from Kyambala, and 281 from Mandi. The largest decrease is from South Kavirondo which shows a total of 190 less during in September. Mandi shows a decrease of 109—Nambwa of 125, and Kital 109.

During October the total number of natives engaged was 14,877 and the number employed, 14,817. The September total of natives employed was 156,623, and the October total 156,952. The October total, less shortage of 18 per cent., allowed for failure of employees to report in full day's work was 66,354. The percentage of the total population reported in employment during the month was 4.99. The

WHEEL WOBBLE.

What It Is and How It is Cased.

A REVIEW OF THE LATEST DATA.

Cause and Cure for Noisy Brakes.

A DIVERSITY OF SUBJECTS.

On road tests the majority of noise which approach except by the regularity of their oscillation are produced by those parts of the car which are not rigidly attached one to the other, but which cannot be moved until they are out of contact. It is in a manner that a part of the brake shoe, for example, is pressed against the drum by a mechanism which allows the pressure to increase and then, to fall momentaneously, and will then jump forward when the load tending to press it away from the shoe becomes too great. It is not impossible that if a super lightened photograph of a squeaking brake would be taken, the drum might actually move backwards during an instantaneous period.

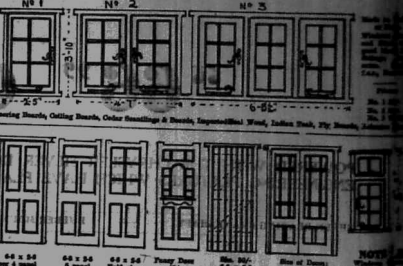

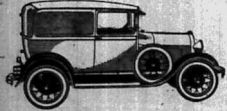

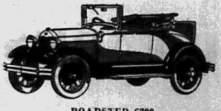
