the way in which native life is affected by labour is a subject on which further careful study is all that is needed. Central Africa, therefore, is not a desert. Any serious consideration of the economic life of the continent must take into account the tribal system and may happen to be misled by tribal authority as the principal factor in administrative policy. 600 convicts were sent to the Congo to work the native people to simulate the ideas and methods of the white man, and to adapt their institutions to the new conditions.

Once Example.

The gravity of this whole problem in another part of Africa has been recognized by the British Government. A Commission presided over by a Minister of State and represented all the interests, including the leading commercial and industrial organizations, was appointed in 1904 to inquire into the conditions of the natives in the following year. In the present year a similar representative Commission, presided over by the Prime Minister, has reviewed the conclusions of the earlier body in the light of the experience of the past three years.

Having envisaged the gravity of the situation, the Commission set itself to work to improve the position of native people. It was found that the natives were being treated as a class of inferior beings, and that their life was being ruined by the conditions of their employment. To Maintain the Control of the Imperial Government.

NO 8. ELECTED WHITE MAJORITY IMPOSSIBLE.

Commission's Plan to Meet the Special Political Position in the Territories.

Having decided that Representative Government is a constructive element which the Executive Government should be responsible to a popularly elected assembly it is impossible to examine other constitutional methods to meet the special position in the Territories.

The Report deals in the first place with an "Elected European Chamber of Government" which would have to be retained in the hands of the white majority in Kenya would be no numerous and important that the degree of white control should be retained.

In view of these difficulties we do not regard the separation of the territories as a desirable solution. It is essential that the form of government should be such as to ensure the inevitable tendency of which is to divide the territories.

In the other hand, there are serious difficulties in giving effect to such a proposal. In the first place, the segregation could never be complete, there must always be a certain admixture of whites in the black areas and a considerable number of blacks in white areas.

The question naturally suggested itself whether the problem of Kenya could be solved by dividing the territories into entirely separate organizations, each of which should be administered by a white or black majority. It is clear that such a plan would be very difficult to carry out.

Kenya might enjoy responsible government. To effect this, however, on these lines it would be necessary, as in all federated organizations, to make a division of subjects between the white authorities and the black authorities. It is clear that the more essential, the one being reserved to the white authorities and the other to the black authorities.

In this matter special reference is made to the fact that the particular constitutional device of a federal system, therefore, is to help towards a solution. The Federal Council of the South Africa is a shining example of the value of such a device.

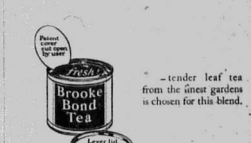

Papain Extraction.

A New Industry for Kenya?

Papain which is extracted from the fruit of the papaya is a drug little known to the general public. The market for it in the U.S.A. is in the order of 100,000 lbs. where its digestive properties are used in the preparation of soluble food and medicinal foods for invalids and dyspeptics. It is also used in the dyeing of wool and in the tanning of skins.

It is a very profitable industry in the tropics. The Department of Agriculture sent a trial sample of papain to England which was favourably reported on by experts. Little, however, seems to have been done in the matter since then. It would probably be advisable for someone proposing to manufacture the drug on a large scale to send a sample to England to start with in order to discover the value and quality.

NO. 9. TASK FOR SELECTED EUROPEANS

Commission Favours Nomination of Officials who are Nearing End of Their Service.

One of the most interesting chapters in the Report of the Hilton Young Commission deals with the changes in the Kenya constitution. The Report deals with the problem of reconciling the legitimate claims of the immigrant communities to a responsible share in the direction of public affairs with the maintenance of Imperial control necessary to discharge the responsibilities of the trusteeship of the native.

The Commissioners think it would be safe and advantageous to relinquish an official majority in the Kenya Legislature in proportion as the powers of the Central Authority are made effective.

Emphasizing the importance of effective representation of the special needs of native areas, the Report, faced with the fact that suitable natives cannot be found, declared its alternative to the selection of Europeans to represent the African.

Missionaries and settlers are both regarded as suitable when properly qualified but the Commission believes the best representatives would be officials who are nearing the end of their service who might be retained and paid a modest honorarium. Four such European representatives of the Native are suggested to begin with, to replace four officials. In addition special regard is taken to provide adequate knowledge of Native opinion, including informal Native Councils, a special study of Native Affairs, an Advisory Committee to assist the Chief Native Commissioner and the inclusion of the European representatives of Natives on all bodies influencing policy.

In any event, the Governor's nominees for the task should be referred to the Central Authority for approval.

MACHINERY TO OBTAIN KNOWLEDGE OF NATIVE MIND.

Having dealt in considerable detail with the political principles on which the recommendations are based, the Hilton Young Commission dwells on the co-ordination of services—military, police, judicial, health, education, agriculture, statistics, communications, defence research and the control of the economy. The Commission lists the common interests of the territories of the continent of Africa. In order to discharge their responsibilities, the Government-Commissioners must have extensive authority and also the power to obtain the assistance of the Central Authority, which may be required for carrying out the proposals.

The Commission would require powers to meet any changes in the Legislative Council of Kenya in order that the power of the Imperial Government over the territories subjects or racial interests might be maintained. The Commission suggests to discuss the relationship between the Government-Commissioners and the Imperial Government, the importance of the development of services of local Government, and the maintenance of law and order throughout Kenya. It is proposed, having regard to a great deal of detail in the past work, the views of the Commission should be published to begin new publication of the Commission's work, which will be known as the Kenya constitution—which is Chapter VIII of the Report.

The Official Majority

If the general principle of one person for the institution of a Central Authority is accepted, we think that it would be both safe and advantageous to relinquish an official majority in the Legislative Council in Kenya, and, in proportion as the powers of the Central Authority are made effective, to look forward to a progressive reduction of official control in the Colony.

There are limits to what is possible in any arrangement, but we propose, notwithstanding these inevitable limitations, to believe it to be possible to create a recognized and effective body which the Government of Kenya and the representatives of the African people would be able to cooperate freely in the conduct of the affairs of the Colony, without interference from outside, and thus within the field of the official representatives could be allowed greater constitutional powers than they have at present, without jeopardizing the maintenance of the main principles of policy for which His Majesty's Government must remain responsible.

It is important, further, that the representatives of native interests in the Council should be associated in the consideration of native opinion.

Secondly, settlers' natives are at present incapable of defending their interests effectively, and also of appreciating what those interests are. It is essential that the effect of the impact of the new civilisation on native institutions, native culture, and the native mind should be the subject of careful study. We have already recommended that it should be part of the functions of the Government-Commissioners to undertake enquiries in regard to native opinion, and that such enquiries will form a growing body of staff and, based on the knowledge about native conditions, will be the duty of the representatives of native interests in the Legislative Council, and will enable them to represent their case with a fuller understanding of all that is involved.

Advisory Committee.

Thirdly, provision needs to be made in Kenya itself for the more thorough consideration of native opinion which requires the attention of the Legislative Council. It is the duty of the Council itself. We think that the object in view can best be attained by the nomination of an Advisory Committee on Native Affairs, to assist the Chief Native Commissioner. The Committee should be strictly advisory, since nothing should be done without the responsibility of the Chief Native Commissioner. PEAK PERIOD OF LOCUST INFESTATION APPROACHING.
Large Swarms Entering Settled and Native Areas

FORMIDABLE VISITATION.

Need for Unceasing Vigilance on the Part of Everybody.

As pointed out some months ago by the officer in charge of the locust campaign the peak period of the present infestation is due at the beginning of February and a special report below indicates that very large swarms from the Northern Frontier Province are now descending on the settled and native areas. But even locusts have their uses, for the dried dead bodies are good for manure and may be used also as an article of food by the natives.

DANGER TO COFFEE.

Eying locusts have entered the agricultural areas. These swarms, it is supposed, are merely the forerunners of a succession of large swarms. Despite the extensive destruction of hoppers and grasshoppers, which is continuing, the remainder of the hoppers which mature, retained by flying swarms from hoppers in the North and East, can and will present themselves a very formidable visitation. The greatest danger at the moment will be to the risk of loss of native "short run" crops, in which the damage has already been done. Other crops in European areas such as "short run" wheat, will be subject to destruction. It is expected that farmers and natives will be unopposed in their vigilance and care as much as possible. Swarms may be expected to reach the Trans Nile within the next few days, but by far the most serious swarms so far reported have come from the North and North East.

Warning to Planters.
 Coffee planters should endeavor to prevent locusts from nesting in their plantations. The greatest risk they run is the possibility of collecting them in the bushes, as that if the opportunity is lost, they will be taken off by the birds.
