




A NEW DISCOVERY FOR AIR PILOTS.

Automatic Lighting Up of Aerodromes.

(THROUGH BRITISH ASSOCIATION.)
News of New Jersey, Feb. 25. The combination of two recent inventions was demonstrated at the air port to-day in response to a letter from an approaching aeroplane, the landing ground was automatically flooded by light from a 25,000,000 candle-power electric beam, without the aid of the ground staff. 


