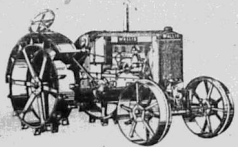

Britain and Washington Convention.

THE PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS. London, March 9. The Minister of Labour, Mr. Bonar Law, has just returned from his trip to Washington to attend the meeting of the governing body of the International Labour Organisation. This meeting is the most important of the first kind in its history, the Ministers of Labour will represent thirty Governments. The chief question is the discussion of the Washington Convention, which was signed by 17 nations and proposed to be ratified.

The report also recommends that the Government should increase the size of the business unit, make among the essential measures to be taken in dealing with Empire matters, the report draws particular attention to the high value of Federal policy.

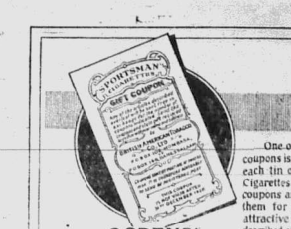

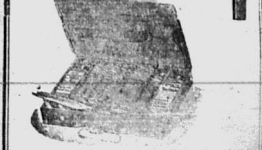

Much Honey Hunting by Natives the Chief Cause of Outbreaks.

The drought conditions in Kenya coupled with abnormally high winds have contributed in the kinangop area to extensive damage which has been done so far by forest fires.

The East African Standard has received details of the situation of Government and settlers who have been brought to the attention of the Department of Forestry in regard to such outbreaks. The details indicate that a fire started in the slope of a hill in the Kinangop area on the 21st of February. The fire, which was reported to have been started by a native, spread rapidly and the extension appeared to coincide with the departure of the local forest officer to the campsite and the departure of the purpose of cutting young trees.

The Assistant Commissioner reported for help to local farmers, who were being urged to help in the work of clearing the forest.

The details state further that by about February 28th the forest was completely free from fire having burned about three weeks, but it is ascertained that the Assistant Commissioner left the district on foot and that the Department will be home again by the beginning of February.

Grass Fires. On February 25th, while the majority of the forest labourers were engaged in the work of clearing the forest, a fire was started on the track which leads to the forest.
