THE FIRST PIG CONFERENCE.

II. PRODUCTION COSTS AND AN EXPORT TRADE.

(Continued).

During the first Pig Conference held in Nairobi recently a considerable amount of discussion as to the possibilities of exporting an export trade for the cost of production more interest. In connection with the pig conference given by the Live Stock Officers, the following was the first instalment of the report of the proceedings as they were held last week.

Travelling Boars.

An extract of a letter from Mr. Morley White was read to the Conference on the subject of Travelling Boars. Mr. McCall advised if cures favoured any particular course of treatment, he would refer the property of a 7-month-old boar and a Berkshire Large Black sow and that this cross produced the best boars for export trade, and suggested that the recently appointed Live Stock Officer should investigate the subject further.

Mr. Thompson proposed and Mr. Grayson seconded that the Conference recommend that bacon stores and pork-butchers should not buy pigs of very inferior quality.

The resolution was carried unanimously and Mr. McCall suggested that such animals be fastened and underwritten to avoid any possible disposal at all.

The Hon. Mr. Gray advised that it would be possible to form a register of good pure bred stock in the Colony to help the smaller trader.

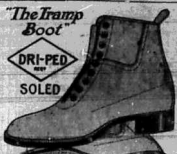

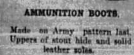

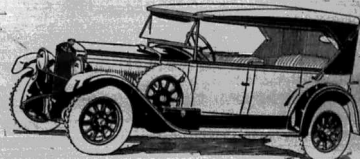
