City Square Favoured for the Central Offices.

The Association of East African Chambers of Commerce at their Eldoret Session endeavored to define the position and responsibility of a delegate nominated by the Association to serve on a Government Committee or Board.

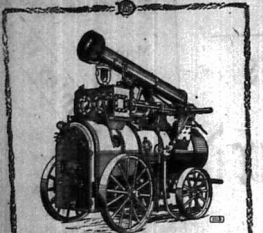

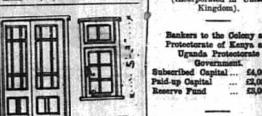

HOME FOOTBALL TOPICS.

Busy Christmas Holiday Period.

HOW THE CLUBS ARE FARING.

WEDNESDAY, COVENTRY—London, by mail. Unlike the majority of other sportsmen professional footballers find no leisure in the Christmas holiday period, for it is during this part of the season that they experience their busiest time.

Some of the more important Association clubs were called on to engage in five matches with five opponents of twelve days which, together with the great deal of travelling which these games entailed, meant that the players would have to be on the road following Saturday, after which clubs would revert to the general routine of one match per week. On Christmas Day and Boxing Day all the clubs in the English League, with but one exception, engaged in home-and-away matches and a surprising feature of these contests was the only seven of the eighty-four clubs participating in the games succeeded in winning both matches.

In the First Division Sheffield Wednesday, champions, journeyed to Everton on Christmas Day and defeated the home team by four goals scored by Hooper (3) and Allen, to one (White) while on the following day the Sheffield team, at home, again beat their opponents by four goals. Leeds (2), Burnley and Aston, in northern League City, scoring through Chandler (2) and Hill (2) defeated Grimsby Town at Grimsby on Christmas Day by 4-1, while on Boxing Day, Chester scored the goal by which the "Chips" repeated their victory over the Town. Huddersfield Town won both their encounters against Hull, by three goals, scored by Mansell (2) and Jackson, to two (Wilson and Gibson) and three goals (Mansell, Kelly and Hill) to one, respectively.

In the Second Division all the results of the Christmas Day fixtures were reversed on the following day, while a similar state of affairs prevailed in the South end section of the Third Division.

Four clubs (Aston, Stanley, Doncaster Rovers, Stockport County and Hartlepool United) were successful in winning their Christmas and Boxing Day matches in the Third Division (Northern section). Ayrton (2) defeated Bradford by 2-1 on Christmas Day, while the same club on the following day, and Leeds by 2 clear goals on the Saturday. 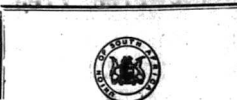
A Taming Struggle.

POWER DEVELOPMENT IN TANGANYIKA

Why Home Opinion Was Opposed to State Scheme.

PRIVATE ENTERPRISE.

Colonial Fund More Useful for Other Purposes.

(*STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.)

Tanzania, January 2.

There is great interest in the announcement that the Power Securities Corporation have been informed by the Colonial Office of the acceptance of its tender for the concession to utilize the Pangani Falls in Tanganyika for the generation of electricity for the supply of the Port of Tanga and the Sital District on the railway from Tanga to the Kilimanjaro Highlands. Apparently, so it learns from Major Walsh, who is the promoter of the undertaking, all the necessary money, which is about £250,000 has been guaranteed, as well as the additional sum of £250,000 which will be required for the extension of the electricity supply to Dar-es-Salaam.

Unfortunately the Governor, Sir Donald Cameron, does not view the latter extension with favour, and is apparently anxious to underwrite the electricity supply of the capital by means of oil driven plant, and for this purpose he is applying to the Colonial Development Fund for a grant. From every point of view, this seems to be a most unfortunate decision.

In the first place, the Pangani Falls are quite capable of generating sufficient electricity to supply the whole of Tanganyika with light and power, and it seems to be almost to suggest that an oil driven plant should be called into existence, backed by public finance, when private enterprise is ready to do the work, and when obviously the easiest and most economical form of propulsion is that of water supply which is ready to hand.

As it stands, the new concession is limited to a radius of sixty miles from the Pangani Falls, and the promoters are very anxious to extend their operations to take in Dar-es-Salaam, and the district. This would, as it say, need an extra £250,000, all of which

money is guaranteed, and a start would be made with the scheme as a whole. The matter is, however, not yet finally settled, and the Government is awaiting the receipt of a dispatch from Sir Donald Cameron, explaining why he prefers an oil driven plant at Dar-es-Salaam, instead of utilizing the available water power of Pangani. 'A Study of the Yearling Sales in this instance.

BETTER CLASS ENTRY FOR THE LINCOLNSHIRE HANDICAP.

As a result of the big drop in prices realized at this year's yearling sales the Racing Form in England occupied a great deal of space in an endeavour to find reasons therefor. An analysis of the figures of past years suggests one or two very potent reasons immediately.

In the first place a number of the big buyers of recent years have been seen to when matters of little account. It has become a matter of indifference to them whether they paid £1,000 or £12,000 for an animal which they regard as the chief lot. It has moved for above their true value. In the present a few of these millionaires have during recent years staked on their own account. This has meant that they have been able to carry on their racing, but they also have a surplus member to sell themselves. Naturally their invasion of the market has meant that the best priced yearlings must have been bitterly disappointed at the poor results of the expenditure. It is not such large sums of money. For instance, the most during 1898, 27 yearlings sold at an average of over 4,000 guineas each, and aggregated the enormous sum of 102,000 guineas. Of these 27 yearlings 13 have since won a race course and so, the following year, as yet, contributed nothing (anything) towards their initial cost.

Quintus-almost 12,500 Guineas, won 3 races worth 15,092. Challenger cost 5,000 Guineas, won 2 races worth 22,250. Early Abbot cost 1,500 Guineas, won 5 races worth 55,132. Blenheim cost 4,100 Guineas, won 4 races worth 14,497. Newmarket December Sales.
