**TECHNICAL ASPECTS OF MOTORING.**  
**How the Petrol Engine Works.**

**"MYSTERIES" EXPLAINED.**  
The paucity of semi-technical literature on the petrol engine and its functioning has been much more than met by the repeated requests I have had for a book which dealt with functional mechanisms in language that is comprehensible to a class of average education and intelligence.

Literature on how an engine functions exists in plenty but it is an inspiring amateur "wants to dig a little more deeply into the 'why' side of the question, he promptly finds himself up against the immense impediment of the lack of knowledge of technical terms, internal calibrations, and so forth with which such works generally bristle.

For the same reason, a student of the thermodynamic side of things in semi-technical language but I must admit says I. Mantel in the "Light Car" that they are unknown to me, and their absence—if I am correct in assuming such—was presumably explainable on the ground that the average motorist rarely wishes to acquire a useful working knowledge of his engine and car and that the proportion of those who are so interested is too small to warrant the production of books, the sale of which possibly might not pay their costs of publication.

The studiously minded can, however, console themselves with the reflection that although much very interesting knowledge would be derived from thermo-dynamic studies of this kind, it would be diluted down with an immense amount of dry-as-dust stuff, such as the mathematical study of what is called the "air cycle" and the calculation of adiabatic curves, which most amateurs would find to be of halting interest.

ity, and when acquired would contribute very little to their store of really useful knowledge. As against this, however, it is a little general knowledge regarding such subjects as thermal, volumetric and mechanical efficiencies with their kindred, and reasons for same would be a desirable acquisition and would show the student the kinds of problems which he must confront the designer in his class after school. These expressions are to be taken, of course, not merely words, often represented in print and occasionally heard, but having little if any actual significance for him.

The "thermal efficiency," frequently—how many amateurs know exactly what "efficiency" means?—is not what you and I feel sure that the proportion of those who like to do a little thing for themselves is rapidly increasing, and in their interests I propose to devote a little space in presenting some of the more advanced physical principles with which designers wrestle in a form that I will endeavor to make as intelligible as possible.

Thermal efficiency is a good example to commence with, as it is well known that the engine can turn into mechanical form in relation to the cross-sectional area actually available, could the engine run at 100 per cent of showing how wasteful are our present methods of engine conversion. I would mention that 25 per cent is regarded as a good conversion figure, and 50 per cent is possible only in very special and highly developed motors.

The petrol engine ranks among the "heat engines" which derive their power by trapping and turning into mechanical form the temporary expansion and consequent compression due to combustion. Every kind of gas or vapor expansion when heated either by its own combustion, as in the case of the petrol engine, or by the application of an external source of heat, as in the case of the steam engine.

The amount of expansion is directly proportional to the heat imparted, and conversely, when the compressed gas or gas does work on a piston its temperature drops as it expands until its pressure is reduced to normal, when the temperature will be the same as that of the air.

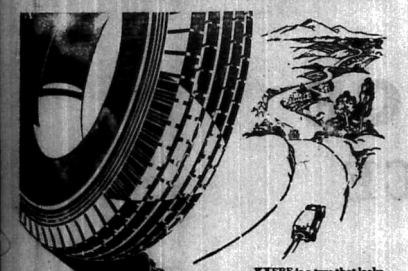

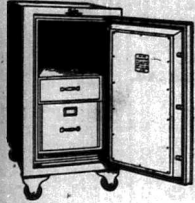

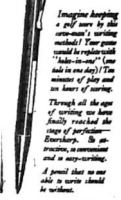

## AFFAIRS IN THE RUGBY WORLD.

### Defeats for the Army and Navy.

#### NORTHERN RUGBY UNION LEADERSHIP.

London, by mail.  
Apart from the international at Belfast, with which I have dealt elsewhere, there were a large number of really interesting Rugby club encounters on Saturday. Both the Army and Navy were engaged in putting the "fringing touch" on the teams that will represent them in the forthcoming inter-services tournament, and the two "Varieties" were in London. Curiously enough, all four were defeated, but only by narrow margins. The Navy, who had by a single point in Blackheath, gave an excellent display that augurs well for their first game with the Air Force on February 6th.

The Army who played the Combined Police of England and Wales at Newport—a very powerful team, indeed—were perhaps a little unfortunate to lose, but the "international" pack of their rivals excelled on a treacherous ground, and this turned the scale. Both A. L. Norris and A. R. Aslett were in good form for the Army. A last-minute dropped goal by R. V. Lancaster, who played for Scotland in their recent game with France, defeated Oxford University, who as is customary may not play their Blues, who although in residence, will not be available for the next "Variety" match. For this reason both T. W. Dobb and R. H. Black were missing Blackheath.

An extremely interesting game at Farnborough saw the Redskins defeat Cambridge University, who failed eight of the ten points defeated by Oxford. A feature of the play was the ex-

cellent combination of J. E. Hutton and J. R. B. Bore—both the English selectors may have made a note of this fact—and the improved form of D. P. Phillips at the base of the scrum, following his scrumming and scrumming and scrumming.


