Over sixty British sportsmen were present at a luncheon held at the Savoy Hotel, London, for the purpose of discussing the Empire Games, to be held at Hamilton, Ontario, next August, and a special session should be taken on the subject of the Mother Country. Sir George McLaren, British Sportsman's general manager of the Canadian Pacific, was the guest of honor, and was supported by well-known sportsmen.

The following resolutions were agreed to— Moved by Lord Desborough and seconded by Lord Ribblesdale: "That in the opinion of the sportsmen of the British Empire, it is the duty of the British Empire Games, in August, 1930, under the gracious patronage of His Majesty the King, should receive the active support of all interested in amateur sport on this side; and that all necessary steps be taken to secure this support."

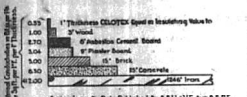

Mr. Galton-Pearl writes as fol-
lows: The Light shows that I had to
chronicle last week have de-
veloped into a veritable downpour
all over Kenya and in most parts
of Uganda and Tanganyika, the
fact rain is general throughout
East Africa. I do not think that
these are the long rains yet, but
ever. It looks rather as if the
weather would continue for about
another week, then we will have
a dry spell for some ten days or
so, after which the long rain
season will begin in earnest.

The wettest place in Kenya this
week is Thika, with 67" of rain;
Upper Kyrenah and Keru with
nearly 50" come next, and Nai-
ruah third with 44". Eldoret
and Lower Kyrenah had 39", and
34" of rain respectively.
In spite of these heavy rains
our country roads are in com-
paratively good condition. One of
my Members left Molo at 10 o'clock
yesterday morning, and arrived in
Nairobi in time for lunch,
which speaks for itself.

The bridges in still down between

sible to motor all round Kenya.

In Uganda, in spite of long
downpours, the roads are excel-
lent, but in Tanganyika, the
Longito-Moshi road is in a very
bad state, and travellers have

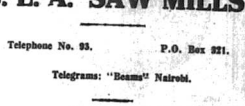

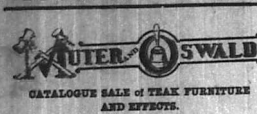

Lame in the Day Time.
So much for one evening gown in the pretty glittering stuff, but lame is as much used in the day time now as it is in the evening. There are many more versions of it than formerly. It is woven in tiny patterns of minute leaves, waves, ripples and diagonal lines, sometimes it is faintly shot with colour and sometimes lined at intervals with gold or platinum—the platinum is very new. Used with satin or crepe, it is a most useful medium for day frocks on occasions when something distinctive is needed.

Sapphire and Silver.
This suit consisted of a flared skirt of sapphire satin, fitted at the waist, a taupe blouse of some silvery-grey satin, with long tight sleeves, and a smartly tailored coat of silver lame with a roll collar of sapphire satin. The coat, which had a pocket each side, was fastened with six diamond-placed buttons of blue-gry mother-of-pearl. Such a suit could easily be worn in the "most quietest" seats at the theatre.

The Blouse Fashion.
Real blouses are made most successfully of lace, and look charming with skirts of black silk. Better still is the effect of a silver lame blouse worn with a skirt to tone or a gold one with

black, and the scratches will no longer be seen.
TO REMOVE SCORCH MARKS.—If a garment has been scorched, by the marked part, cover the place with a piece of blotting paper, and rub it with a mixture of soap, starch and water. Rub the mixture on top and leave it in the sun, continually maintaining the starch marks until it dries away.

SAVOYED VEGETARIAN PUFFER DASH.

For 6 average potatoes, use 2 eggs, 2 eggs butter, 2 oz. Cheshire cheese, 2 oz. flour (self-rising), 1/2 cupful milk, salt and pepper to taste. Peel the potatoes, par-boil them, drain, and allow to cool. Mince or grate them, put them into a large bowl and beat smooth. Add the whites of the eggs and beat till creamy. Add the butter—just melted, not hot—and the finely grated cheese. Mix well and beat in, separately, the flour, the milk, plenty of salt and pepper, and the egg whites beaten to a froth. Butter a pudding dish, turn in the mixture, and bake in a moderate oven. Serve piping hot.

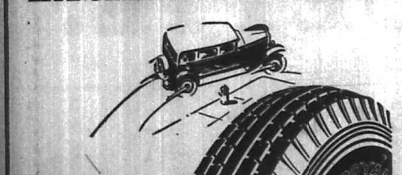

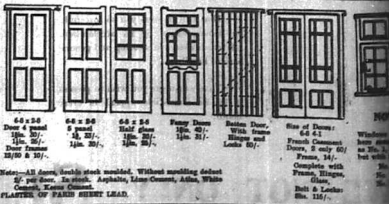
