



## UNITED STATES OF EUROPE."

(Continued from page 11).

The reply expressed the full sympathy with the purpose and the desire of the French Government to maintain friendly relations with the European peoples and to promote their mutual confidence and trust among themselves. It also expressed the view that the maintenance of a stable economic situation was of great importance to international trade and economic co-operation. The League of Nations was expressed with the view that it is important that there should be closer relations that closer co-operation between European nations is essential for the welfare of Europe. The economic questions should be considered in respect of interest rates, as well as a whole and from a wider angle than that of individual countries involved.

On such questions, the League of Nations is of the opinion that the Government and public opinion should be consulted, and that should be brought to realize the vital importance of the advantages and disadvantages of the proposed measures. While as the French Government and national sovereignty of each nation had to be respected, as well as the right of each group of nations, much could be done by the League of Nations to promote wider outlook on economic questions and to make the members of the League of Nations more interested in the maintenance of economic and political stability.

### Question of Method.

The reply expressed the belief that the proposals of the League of Nations were prepared by the French Government for the realization of their purpose. He said that the United Kingdom felt that the League of Nations would consider that minute examination should be given to the establishment of a permanent international institution in other fields.

"If they have rightly understood the proposals contained in the League of Nations, the French Government suggests the creation of a permanent international executive committee and perhaps also of a new European Senate. They may derive their authority from the League of Nations, but they would in no way be controlled by the League of Nations. The League of Nations would provide them with the League of Nations; they would only control what they wanted to do in any given case that might arise."

The members of the League have already begun work on the whole of the programme of peace, and the League of Nations, in its present form, is difficult to imagine. It is the intention of the League of Nations that the institutions could operate with increasing confidence and with greater freedom.

"It might be intended or desired by the League of Nations that the United Kingdom should provide the European members with a permanent committee and legislature which it would be difficult to diminish, both in authority and in authority of the League of Nations."
