



our reform Council what decision Government have arrived at with regard to a wheat pool and the prohibition of the importation of wheat and what action they propose to take?

To this the Colonial Secretary gave the following written reply: "The whole question of the establishment of a wheat pool and separate exchange has been closely considered by Government."

It is evident that if the chief wheat countries are to be any way clear to enter into an operating agreement the main object sought would be achieved without delay and intervention by legislation would be unnecessary.

Government is advised and it is impossible to operate such legislation before the forthcoming year is reached. The opportunity, however, remains of introducing legislation in due time if it is considered desirable to do so.

### Regulations

Government has laid its hand by request in view of compliance with the provisions of the proposed law. It will be prepared to do anything in its power to bring them into effect. In these negotiations, Government will give further consideration to the feasibility of introducing legislation concerning the sale and distribution of wheat and wheat flour for local consumption.

Government has taken a great deal of evidence on the subject of the possibility of prohibiting the importation of wheat flour, and will announce its decision shortly.

Acting out of this matter, Capt. the Hon. B. M. V. Kennedy sought information from whom the request emanated since they were not the subject of the Government's attention. The Colonial Secretary would only reply that the negotiations with the Government were in connection with the Secretary's permission by the speaker, was not a liberty to give the information.
