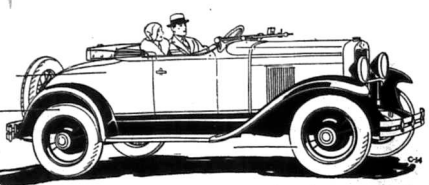

### COMMONS QUERY ON STATUS OF C. N. C.

The changed status of the Chief Native Commissioner was referred to in the course of a question and answer in the House of Commons.

Mr. G. H. Buxton (Labour, Bristol) asked the Under-Secretary of State for the Colonies whether any changes have been contemplated in the status of this Chief Native Commissioner.

The Under-Secretary (Colonial Secretary) said: "It is the status of the Chief Native Commissioner that is under consideration."

Dr. Shikha (in March, 1925) the Government appointed the present Chief Native Commissioner for the reorganisation of the Provincial Administration in Kenya. Previously, districts in which there were no native reserves had been administered by the Government appointed Resident Commissioners under the direct supervision of the Colonial Secretary, while native reserves and a few districts which embraced both native reserves and non-native development were grouped in Provinces under Resident Commissioners immediately responsible to the Chief Native Commissioner.

The Chief Native Commissioner (Colonial Secretary) said: "The Chief Native Commissioner is a non-native official appointed by the Government through the Colonial Secretary. He is in direct communication with the Government through the Colonial Secretary in the same way as other officials and departments, and the normal procedure followed when the Government desire general discussion with the head of a Department is always applied in his case. The Chief Native Commissioner is a non-native official appointed by the Government through the Colonial Secretary and in the Legislative Council, and the only alteration in the status of the post is that which resulted in the arrangement of his duties."

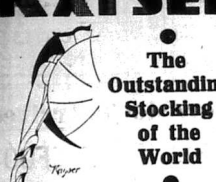

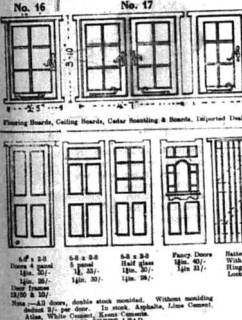

IMPERIAL BROADCASTING.

boats to Mombasa, with the possibility of using flying-boats only once a week from the northern route within two years.

The southern section from Kilimanjaro via Dar-es-Salaam to the Cape is to be opened by April 1, 1931, and will be operated by first-class aeroplanes with a stopover station at Kilimanjaro. Workshops are being established at Gabiro, Kismayu and Johannesburg.

The agreement for subsidizing the operation was signed by the Government of Durban, Aug. 18. The service will take eight days from Johannesburg, connection with the London-India service, thus providing an 11 days service from London to the Cape.

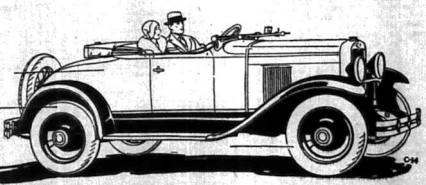

**AN AIRSHIP ON RAILS.**

#### New Railplane System of Transport.

STUCCOBLOC DEMONSTRATION

Prominent engineers who in 1924 were among the 25 pioneers in the successful first demonstration of the George Bemie Railplane at Miltonvale near Glasgow, expressed the opinion that the railplane system will in all probability, have an effect on the speeding up of transport in the future, as far-reaching as that of the introduction of the steam train just one hundred years ago.

At Miltonvale a complete rail plane station has been constructed over the working L.N.E.R. track. The terminus close to the main road. The track has been carried out in secret, and that station is closely guarded so that no one can see the railplane, which is being built in the landscape than an ordinary railway.

### The Railplane.

The Bemie Railplane consists of an enclosed streamlined car, eight feet high and fifty feet in length. It resembles a miniature straight motor car on an overhead track. The car is propelled by air screws—8 feet length—attached to the front and rear ends. It is driven by two 60 hp electric motors on much the same principle as that adopted for the Bemie. The body is constructed of the lightest known material, aluminium, and is painted grey, and the total weight of the car is just over 8 tons.

The railplane may be adapted for practically any purpose—for the conveyance of passengers, mail, express goods, or even for the transport of oil or other fluids in bulk.

**DOE TO FALL IN PRICE OF SILVER.**

[STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.]

(London, by mail.)

In the British market silver is selling at only worth 1 1/2, which is a fall considerably later. The proportion of the silver in the market, and the consequence that an ounce of silver now makes more than 100 of gold.

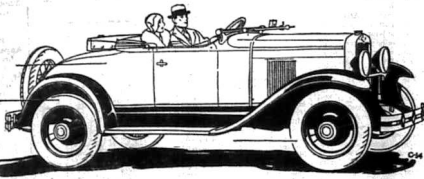

### TRAINING OF AFRICAN TEACHERS.

#### Valuable Work of the Jeanes School.

#### USEFUL SOCIAL SUBJECTS.

#### Instruction on Health, Hygiene and Agriculture.

The system adopted by the Jeanes School in the training of young Africans as teachers has been described in an interesting review by Mr. J. W. C. Dougal, the Principal of the institution.

The object of the School is to train the pupil to teach his fellow countrymen in the reserves, not only by giving class-room subjects, but in social and agricultural subjects, so as to improve the life of the native generally.

The staff of specialists train these students in a variety of subjects, chiefly with a view of producing good teachers. The curriculum includes simple health and hygiene, improved agricultural methods in dairying and cattle-keeping, and carpentry and housing.

#### WOMEN PUPILS.

Mr. J. W. C. Dougal, Principal of the Jeanes School at Kabete, has written an account of the training of women pupils at the school. The Jeanes School at Kabete was the first of its kind in the whole of Kenya to have a girls' school. It was started in 1910 and has since then been steadily increasing in size. At present there are 120 girls in the school, and the staff consists of 10 women teachers.

The girls are taught in a variety of subjects, including English, arithmetic, and history. They also receive instruction in domestic science, including cooking and needlework. The school also has a library and a playground.
