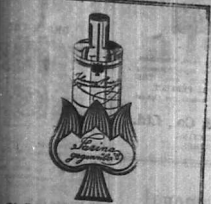

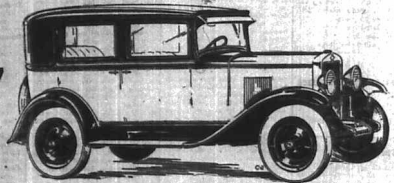

COLONY'S EXPENSES CUT BY £91,400.

Government's Task in Preparing the Budget.

VERY FEW NEW WORKS.

Equity To Be Made Into System of Travelling Allowances.

In looking the preparation of the Estimates, Government has set the task of cutting the departmental proposals for 1918-19 to a surplus of £50,000 for the Colony's balance.

The total sum which had to be cut out to make the 1918-19 balance show an adequate margin was £87,700.

This has been done by cutting the recurrent costs of the Colony down by £115,400 and the non-recurrent by £27,300.

Having made all these adjustments, the actual decrease in the Colony's proposed expenditure in comparison with the approved figure for this year is £91,400.

One of the most interesting announcements is that being doubtful whether it gets value for the large amount every year spent on travelling allowances.

Proposals have been put forward for having in view the present financial straits the Government propose to hold a full inquiry into the whole question of travelling allowances to departments.

The inquiry will include consideration of the relative values of Government-owned cars and taxis and the other method of making mileage allowances to officers of privates.

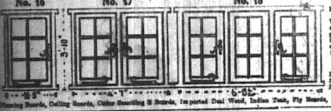

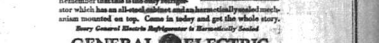

FURTHER OPPOSITION TO PALESTINE POLICY.

Mr. Lloyd George Denounces the Government.

PROTEST BY GENERAL SMUTS.

Statement Described as Breach of National Faith.

Further opposition has been expressed to the recent statement by Government in regard to its policy in Palestine.

Mr. Lloyd George has associated himself with the conservative leaders' protest. During the course of a speech he expressed the opinion that the Government's policy looked too much like a breach of national faith.

The President of the French Palestine Committee described the Government's policy as "one of the most atrocious episodes in British history." He added that the fight was now not between the British Government and the Jewish people, but between Britain and the League of Nations.

General Smuts, who was a member of the Imperial War Cabinet when the Balfour Declaration was issued, has also written to Mr. Ramsay MacDonald expressing his deep disappointment at the Government's decision. He says that the Balfour Declaration is a debt of honour which must be discharged at all costs.
