ANOTHER WHITE PAPER ON NATIVE POLICY.

Lord Passfield's Reply to Northern Rhodesia.

Views are reconcilable. Has No Intention of Departing From Stated Policy.

Lord Passfield's reply to a request by the Elected Members of Northern Rhodesia for a conference on the subject of native policy in East Africa has been published as a White Paper.

The Secretary of State's answer is a blunt negative. He declares he has no intention of departing from the policy laid down in 1922, and in his own subsequent Memorandum.

Northern Rhodesian Elected Members either indicated contempt by white replies or they indicated contempt by natives. In which they would get equal treatment with natives. By this was meant amalgamation with Southern Rhodesia.

RELIEVED PASSENGER ABORNS AT NAIROBI.



POLITICAL ARMISTICE PROPOSED

DELEGATES' ADVICE TO COUNTRY

Withdrawal of Debated White Papers.

A GENERAL ELECTION

To Return to London with Clear and Agreed Policy.

The Rt. Hon. Lord Delamare and the Hon. T. J. O'Shea address a public meeting in Nairobi last evening on the results of their visit to England.

The delegation propose a "political armistice" for two main reasons, one because they do not believe that a satisfactory settlement can possibly be obtained in the present condition of opinion in the Colonies, and the other because of a mass of undisputed facts on East Africa and many grave and still unsettled issues, foreign and Imperial problems, and two, because Kenya is suffering during the present economic crisis to waste its efforts in further political controversy.

The main points in the advice which the Delegation gives the country are:

1. That the present Memorandum on Native Policy should be withdrawn.
2. That consideration of Closer Union should be adjourned indefinitely.
3. That the Kenya settlers are not preferring any request to the Joint Committee for any immediate step forward in the Colony's constitution.

To settle Inter-Colonial disputes, the delegation propose a Advisory Standing Committee of each Legislature, which would meet regularly, alternately in the three Territories to discuss common difficulties and problems.

Emphasis was laid on the fact that this issue will be discussed in all its bearings at a General Election in Kenya after which it is suggested that the delegation return to England to lay the views of the Colony before the Joint Committee.

Another proposal is a private discussion with the Government of Southern Rhodesia regarding subjects of common interest affecting the issue.

A great tribute was paid to the South African Premier whose intervention is regarded as the most important factor on the whole situation in the territories.

Generally, the Delegation are satisfied that the opinion of responsible people in Britain has changed considerably in favour of the views of the settlers of East Africa.

It is felt that a truce would be the best thing that could happen to the Territories and the best contribution they could make to the mother country, and that the advantage should be taken of the present difficulties in Britain to retire into obscurity for the purpose of concentration on the grave economic problems which have brought Kenya to the edge of a precipice.
