

Withdrawal of Debated White Papers.

A GENERAL ELECTION.

To Return to London with Clear and Agreed Policy.

The Rt. Hon. Lord Delamere and the Hon. T. J. O'Shea addressed a public meeting in Nairobi on Thursday evening on the results of their visit to England.

The main points in the advice which the Delegation give the country are:
