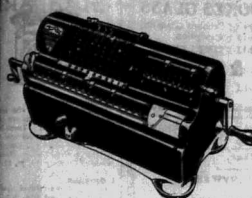

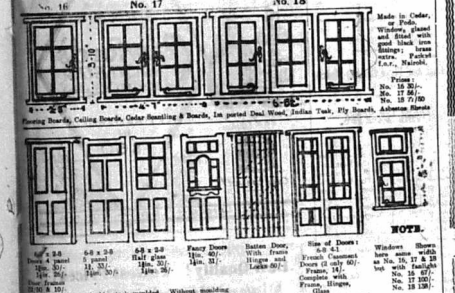

FLOWERS AT THE SHOW.

The Show of the Agricultural and Horticultural Society of Kenya held in Nairobi was not too well fitted in the Horticultural Society, but organized under the auspices of the Horticultural Society, but thanks are due to all those who gave their services to this purpose. The judging was fairly easy, inasmuch as that there was only one entry in some cases.
The roses were not so good as usual. Mr. Graham Hill had the only collection of about 50 varieties; these were well arranged, and so greatly benefited by the weather being named. In the roses Mrs. Bennett from the Mau Hills was an easy first and considering that it was her first effort, and the best she had ever done, I think they were fairly creditable. The next exhibitor was the sister of one of the exhibitors, viz. Mrs. M. Bennett from the Mau Hills was first and she also won the prize for the best flower in the Show with a good Lady Hillingdon.

Mr. Graham Hill forgot that the blooms of roses of these late Show, should be shaded from the violent sun, which takes out all the color. If this is done we shall see the true color of these beautiful flowers.
Carnations were shown by Mr. J. Ingey, who with his twelve and eleven, but the best was the one shown by Mr. A. L. Goodall, and I may add that these three were the best individual flowers I have ever seen at the first Linone Show.
The cut flowers were good but there was only one exhibit of 12 varieties which were from Mr. and Mrs. Ingey, who also won the first prize in the thirty varieties too; in this was good. The display was Williams, Abrehamson, and Trade.

Mr. Ingey had several second prizes, notably a pair yellow and Montrose Sweet Sulphur and Fongolva, all these exhibits were well arranged, and were clean and bright looking. Staines were very good from Mr. C. Mann, Kyanika, his miniature Hesperangia types, and varieties, were really wonderful, the exhibit was very well arranged, these flowers like very rich ground, and must be well irrigated. It is well a change of ground is necessary, and deep cultivation.
The Geraniums were good and best arranged in the second prize list from Mr. Graham Hill, Mr. G. L. Langridge, and the first prize, but although he was best looking, the arrangement might have been a great deal improved. The pot plant of Mrs. Bennett which was first and best, was from Mrs. Bennett from the Mau Hills, having five blooms and green leaves with white spots. It was the best specimen I have ever seen in the Show. The second prize was from Mr. R. E. Randall for a Geranium with a leaf of a deep red white, quite a well grown plant of six feet and showed good cultural skill. Only one exhibit of Verbena was shown of 11 varieties, from Mrs. Ingey who got 1st prize with it.
Bulbous plants were well shown by Mr. Graham Hill, great variety and an interesting exhibit. Mr. H. M. Gardner of the Arterton had a most interesting exhibit of plants in flower, Wagnia, Curia, Colpasia, Scilla, etc. of a very good kind, and all were well arranged. The best were from Mr. R. E. Randall by Eubonia, Scilla, "Madonia" was very superior and first in the class. Delphiniums from Mr. McRobb were worth a lot to see, but they were not so good as the first time he exhibited them, but they did not look like the best in advance of the old type which has been previously known for years to various persons.
The unusual finding of a plant from the Mau Hills exhibited by Mr. H. M. Gardner, a curious flower something like a stapelia but with different growth. The second prize went to Mr. Graham Hill for a new Rose sport from Queen's River. The individual plants went to a deep mauve Thymus from Mr. G. L. Langridge.

Mr. Ingey's Mrs. Ingey's were fresh and looked fit to eat and Miss Poland had good Tomatoes, and the Cobby's have some much better from her garden. The Marrows were two coarse, and here the Catholic Mission had the only tender ones, but I think that they are improving. Salads were the opportunity. Rhubarb was good. Potatoes were poorly represented at the Show. Pans were very good indeed from Big class, G. O. Artherton, a new exhibitor in our Vegetable class.
Tropical Fruit was good. 21 boxes from Mr. Graham Hill, who also won Citrus Fruits with 15 exhibit. The same exhibitor had five kinds of Passion Fruit. Strawberries were excellent from Mr. L. Goringe, the best that I have yet seen in Kenya. Mrs. Ingey was first with good examples. Mrs. Dillard had the best 'Pawpaw' and Mrs. Bennett second best. Mrs. Bennett had peaches in the best condition, although Mr. Goldman had the largest. Mr. Langridge had the best cooking and dessert apples and the best collection of berries, 14 kinds. He also won with peaches, the class for any other variety of fruit. The Catholic Mission was all the best done. The Floral Display was from Mr. R. E. Randall, 2nd Mr. G. L. Langridge with a display of fruit packed for export; this is the first time an exhibit of this kind has been put up in Kenya, and with more care in packing. I am sure this exhibit will be an inspiration to many who are in the habit of packing fruit for export, and it is a great help to firm packing, no matter how small, to be able to move the fruit. This exhibit also had a special commendation from the Judges, showing plain appreciation of the effort, towards the encouragement of fruit growing in Kenya.

A Remarkable Display
In the many other plants or flowers not provided in the schedule, I must especially mention the exhibit of Eubonia from Mrs. Graham Hill. I had over 125 roses, including about 2,000 blooms. Never before have I seen such an exhibit of this one flower, the arrangement was beautiful and must have tried the patience of whoever arranged them.
I am of the opinion that had this been shown in London, it would have gained the T.B.S. Silver Gift Plant Medal. Had it been possible to have had it at the Chelsea Show I have no doubt it would have won the Society's Standard Silver Cup.
The second prize awarded to Mrs. Ousey for her Wallflowers was run very closely by the Sweet Williams of Mr. Eusebe, both were a revelation and it was only the difficulty of collection, which decided the matter in the judge's minds. They were both really lovely so were the Daisies.

Flowering Shrub from Kyanika included Indian Aster, as the most rare.
Fruit and Vegetables.
Vegetables were no coarse altogether, and the majority came from the Catholic Mission. I would like to remind them that all vegetables should be eaten and young at that, combined with natural cleanliness. The six varieties

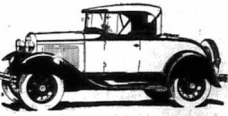

CREDIT REQUIREMENTS OF COFFEE INDUSTRY.

Scheme Discussed by Board of Agriculture.

A CREDIT CORPORATION.

Government to Provide Half of £200,000 Capital.

A method of financing the Coffee Industry through the provision of the special credit needs is outlined in an Appendix to the Board of Agriculture's recent Memorandum.

The proposals were made by Capt. W. Tyson, and took the form of a Credit Corporation with a capital of £200,000, one half of which would be subscribed by Government.

On the basis of the capital the Company would borrow £200,000 on seasonal credits.

Planters wishing to obtain a loan would so be paid by a levy on their coffee.

It was calculated that the savings in handling the crop would not be less than £10,000 per annum.

The Board in criticising the scheme thought the initial charges too heavy and considered that savings should be used for the immediate benefit of the planters instead of going to a Reserve Fund.

A £10,000 Saving.

The second Appendix to the recently published memorandum on Agricultural Credits presented to the Government of Kenya by the Board of Agriculture, contains a scheme proposed by Capt. W. Tyson, M.C., for the formation of a credit corporation to finance the Coffee Industry.

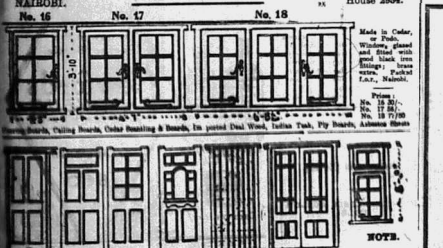

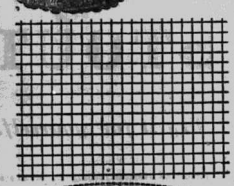
