Establishment of "Indirect Rule" in Native Affairs.

His Excellency Sir Donald Cameron left Dar es Salaam yesterday afternoon at the close of his period of office as Governor of Tanganyika. He has been appointed Governor of Nigeria.

Donald's work in the Mandated Territory will rank amongst the most important performed by any Governor of East Africa.

His greatest—and most critical—contribution was the establishment of the system of indirect rule in native principle in native policy. He carried out for Tanganyika what Lord Lugard did for Nigeria.

He is also responsible for the change in the Constitution which provided for the enlargement of the Legislative Council and the inclusion of Nominated Unofficial Members therein.

His appreciation of Sir Donald's Governorship in Tanganyika is published below.

but refused to pay the tax and eventually demanded to be allowed to depart. A strong force of police barred the gates. The deadlock was ended with the arrival of Lord Irwin. The arrangements between the Government and the Congress leaders revealed that the conditions called earlier are granted and all representative measures with force.

The general impression is that unless these four conditions are conceded there is no hope of a settlement.

The meeting passed a resolution endorsing the Working Committee's decision that the civil disobedience movement must continue unabated unless there are explicit instructions to the contrary received from the Government.

A second resolution was passed declaring that the boycott of foreign goods must remain a permanent feature of national activity until the nation had acquired the power to exclude foreign goods from India by total prohibition for prohibitive tariff.

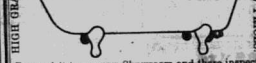

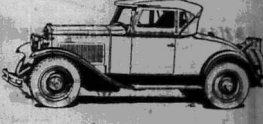

WIRELESS IN EAST AFRICA.

PRINCIPLES OF THE CRYSTAL SET.

The Crystal Set.

(Continuing with the crystal set. This is the simplest of all receivers and the most theory of its working is not very complicated. With a pair of telephones joined into an aerial wire nothing will be picked up for the simple reason that telephones will not allow the very weak telephonic vibrations that would be set up in it due to the action of the broadcasting station. In any case owing to the absence of tuning the notes of such a receiver would be extremely small. If a device, such as a crystal detector was put in series with the pair of telephones in the aerial a different set of conditions would be set up. The property of the crystal (and valve etc.) is that it allows current to flow one way only.

The carrier wave from the broadcasting station sets up in any aerial a continuous and so far constant, alternating at a high frequency, as the frequency comes depending to the wavelength of the station. The action of the crystal

is to allow the carrier wave to flow through the telephones on the other side of the crystal. The crystal and telephones are connected in series with the aerial. The only limit is "how" tuned by the variable condenser. Then the crystal oscillates in sympathy with the broadcasting station to which it is tuned. The effect will be impressed on the detector telephones. In this case a little damping is impressed on the crystal. The effect is as in a secondary circuit.

Tapping Points.

A better effect is obtained by using two or more or multiplicity of coils to allow of two tapping points being taken. The aerial in this case is connected to the top of the coil and the other end of the coil to the top of the second coil. The crystal circuit is taken from the top of the coil through the crystal through the telephones to the second tapping. Also from the top of the coil to the second tapping is joined a variable condenser. This is said to be in parallel. This allows tuning the aerial circuit and the secondary circuit. The aerial is to remain in many tunes as the second aerial, forming the secondary circuit which allows that circuit to be tuned to any frequency.

Since this still almost consisted of one coil doing two duties the question arises why not use two separate coils. In this case circuit is aerial through a variable condenser to earth. Secondary coil will be in series with the crystal. Other side of variable condenser to bottom of secondary coil. Since this allows tuning to bottom of secondary coil. Better tuning can be obtained since the distance between the two coils can be varied and what is called the coupling can be adjusted. There is for each station a certain optimum position for these two coils. This completes this type of receiver. There have been many variations of this type of receiver or three stands on each station but the main and unvariable principle is the same in each case and when the circuit is dimmed it will be found to be one of the above simple forms plus trimming. 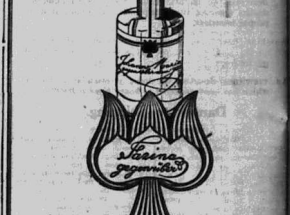

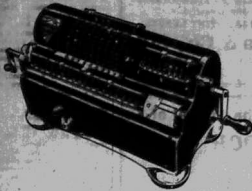

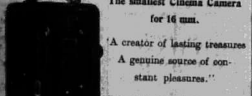
