WHERE THE AMATEUR GOES WORKS.

The first step in making a garment is to cut out the material, and have many mistakes go wrong. When you open out a paper pattern, you will notice that every seam is either indicated by numbers, or by letters, and you will see that the material, one may find that the numbers or numbers are placed on the wrong side of the dress. 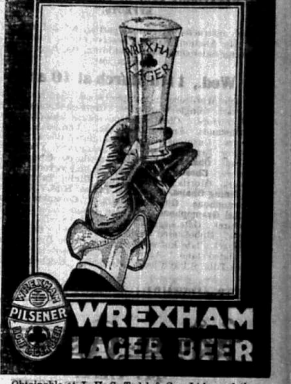

PREPARING FOR THE BUDGET.

Estimated Cost of Supply Services.

(BY WIRELESS)

Friday, March 8.

With the publication of the first estimates for the most financial year, the requirements for all the supply services are known and a rough estimate of the amount of the budget is possible.

For the fighting services a sum of £100,000,000 is required, representing a decrease of £40,000,000 on last year's estimate.

Civil costs will probably be £170,000,000, representing an increase of £2,000,000 and Revenue Departments will cost £112,000,000, being a decrease of £50,000,000. This represents the requirements for the supply total increases over last year's £211,000,000.

Provision that is to be made for sick and convalescent land services will not be known until Budget Day but assuming that it remains the same as last year, the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Mr. Snowden, would have to provide a sum of about £200,000,000 against last year's three years' estimate of £187,000,000.

AGE OF THE CREATOR.

London, February 12.
The clergy of the country have been unusually well represented in the wireless world in that they have been more striking than for years past in their presence at the wireless congress. He said: "I repeat that the wireless world is a wonderful and some- times contradictory thing, which the wireless points on the public mind is creating in the general mind a temperament of universal scepticism which cannot but be highly injurious to the reputation of the Christian Church; just as that head- casting has come to stay, and the Christian Church must accept the scepticism which it fosters as one of the conditions."

HEAVY SNOWSTORM OVER BRITAIN.

Main Roads Rendered Impassable.

CITY BLAZE.

Firemen Suffer from Exposure to Cold.

The heaviest snowstorm for many years driven by a squally North-East wind has seriously slowed up all outdoor movement in London.

The proposed flight of two flying boats to Gibraltar from whose sister ships was involved in Plymouth disaster last month) to participate in the Fleet exercise has been abandoned owing to adverse weather.

The snowstorm further hampered the firemen at a great fire involving a tea and rubber warehouse on Saturday night at Butler's Tower Bridge.

A picturesque effect is caused by volumes of smoke pouring from the roof while the framework of the building is festooned with ice.

Exceptionally severe weather continues throughout Britain, which is still under snow. The forecast indicates further snowfalls with low day temperatures and severe frosts at night.

The cost of the damage done to the warehouse fire which broke out at Butler's Wharf on Tower Bridge last Saturday, and which is still smouldering, is estimated provisionally at nearly £250,000. A large proportion of the loss is attributed to the destruction of damage to the stock of sheet rubber—British Official Wireless Service.

"Daguerri," Daguerri is quite responsible as present. It was never revealed last year by the Company's agents. It is only built once now, by a force of 70 men in a strongly built structure, and it is intended to last for 100 years. A few other plants are there, as well as a small house where we can stay in comfort. The character of the Wa-Kikuyu, who are less trustworthy than the Wa-Kamba, and at present some of the Wa-Kikuyu are difficult to deal with. We shall reach Daguerri by and by, but not too late.

"Machiko." The advantages of this site are as follows—2,000 feet higher than Kilowat, and therefore cooler; more people in the vicinity; to the north, and east, and west, a splendid view of the country. It is situated on the edge of the plateau which stretches away in a westerly direction to the sea. It is a part of the Wa-Kamba and the one side and the other side of the Wa-Kikuyu on the other. These places have at present no fixed population. The disadvantages of the site are—very distant from the Coast; great security of timber and the ready supply of water. The country was a bit disturbed, and they had been a good deal of fighting only two months previously.

Start at Kilowat.

"Kilowat therefore was chosen as the site of the Mission's activities at this time, though the site of all looked eventually to reach Malakula and later Daguerri. It was founded like the Station, Malakula further south, first on a mission basis to all its work, second educational, third medical, and fourth industrial. It has remained true to its type through the years that have passed, while the other two have been abandoned, and was included definitely.

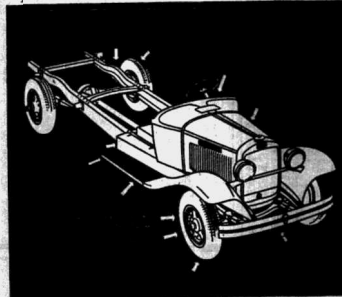

Railway Economies. It has been general knowledge for some time that the Administration of the Kenya and Uganda Railways and Harbours contemplated a reduction in the main train services in the interests of economy. An announcement published today gives details of the proposed changes. Although they will inflict inconvenience on the travelling public, it will be agreed that as a whole they are much less drastic than the conditions might have warranted. After they have been in operation for a while, it should be possible to gauge the measure of their effect. It is quite certain that this class of travellers should continue to be encouraged to use the country's railways by all reasonable means within the power of the authorities. This is a question in which immediate consideration is given in most progressive years with the result that on some of the main routes the Colony of Kenya, especially where they are crowded with the railway, private enterprise, is creating serious loss to the public revenue. It is a matter for consideration whether the general question of road versus rail competition should not definitely include the question of passenger traffic. It has been stated by the Government that the new passenger facilities is as high as 200,000 per year in 1920.
