The most important review of the present situation in Kenya provided during the present election campaign was contained in a speech by the Hon. Lord Delamere delivered at a meeting of his constituents at Nairobi.

Lord Delamere has also issued a brief personal manifesto on economic and political subjects.

In the course of his address he championed the fiscal system which has been in operation for the last ten years and expressed the view that it should be continued with a further measure of protection if necessary.

Lord Delamere stated that there was an expected deficit of revenue of £138,000 and to meet this Government had cut expenditure by £150,000.

He maintained that if a Committee had been appointed some months ago the alternative of a salary cut in Civil Service salaries could have been examined and would have avoided to a great extent the necessity for retrenchment.

He expressed the opposition to any form of closure at the moment as Kenya might get something she did not want and a sound policy in the future would thereby be prevented.

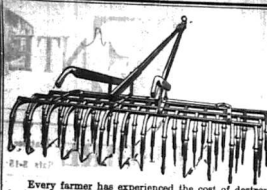
