## CAWNPORE RIOTS ASSUME SERIOUS PROPORTIONS.

### Four Hundred People Dead and Wounded.

### RIGID CENSORSHIP.

### Police Reinforcements Drafted Into the City.

The communal riots which broke out in Cawnpore following protests against the Lahore executions have assumed serious proportions.

The latest casualty list puts the number of dead at one hundred whilst in addition 300 people have been admitted to hospital.

Gandhi in a statement strongly condemned "this strife."

Mr. Winston Churchill in a speech in London declared that he would continue to fight against the Government's present policy in India. He instanced the Cawnpore riots as part of the result of the present imperial policy.

In Burma rebels attacked a police outpost with the result that there were twenty casualties to the rebels. Two important rebels were killed later when the police attacked a rebel stronghold in the jungle.

### Looting and Burning Continue.

New Delhi, March 26. A message from Cawnpore states that a rigid censorship has been ordered. No definite figures of casualties are available, but the dead are said to be at least 100, while many are still in hospital. The streets have been looted and burning continues.

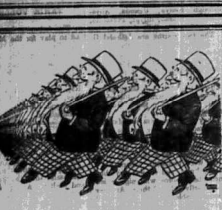

### Locals in Uganda.

#### GOODS TRAIN DELAYED NEAR JICA.

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.  
Kampala, March 21.  
The rains have definitely to have come and nearly a day passing now without a storm of any sort. Matters are already clearing ground in preparation of the planting of food crops and there are signs of activity on all the small estates which make up this country.  
Lapses have been a great nuisance during the past few days, flying over far hours in what seem to be unaccountable delays. In one case a goods train could make no progress at all for over five hours on a gradient only 1/4 mile owing to the masses of locusts that had been killed on the rails, making them so slippery that the wheels would not grip. As far as can be ascertained the particular brand of insect that is in Uganda at present confines itself to eating elephant grass and, possibly, maize cane. This is all right in the Uganda Province as there is plenty of elephant grass for them to feed on, but it is a different matter in the Eastern Province, where there is little or none of the grass and consequently the food crops may be threatened.

#### A Memorandum.

The Entomologist has issued a memorandum on the habits of locusts and hoppers to all District officers and Agricultural officers together with hints as to the manner in which they should be dealt with. Among other suggestions he says—  
"Food likely to be attacked should be planted in greater quantities than usual in view of the greater liability of grass-like plants to attack."

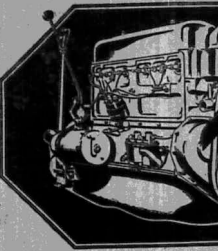
