Commercial Witness Defends Settlers' Interest in Native Problems.

Mr. W. Tyron expressed his evidence before the Joint Committee, the Chairman agreed with his view that vague terms such as "projections of the Secretary of State," "dual trusteeship" etc., exported into a country Africa led to confusion and difficulties and the more they could get away from them the further they would get ahead.

Writes for Labour Party. Dr. Drummond Shiels caused confusion by asking whether the witness was when in showing their dissent to the Government's statement so plainly, as in the case of the witness.

LIGHT RAIN AT COAST AND AT RIVERMOUTH.

The British East Africa Meteorological Service in its report on weather conditions as reported from selected stations in East Africa, up to 9 a.m. yesterday states that the rainfall reported during the past twenty-four hours is—Mombasa 0.16 inch, Kisumu 0.12, Kericho 0.01, Nakuru 0.01, Eldoret 0.01, Timbavatu 0.21 inch. The minimum temperature fell to below 50 deg. F. at Fort Portal, Nakuru, and Eldoret. At Kisumu the maximum was 79 deg. F. and the minimum 53 deg. F. Southerly winds still prevail over the whole area.



The Kenya Department of Agriculture issued recently a summary of the European Agricultural statistics for the year ended in February last. The figures show satisfactory progress (despite the difficult marketing conditions). Comparisons are made with the figures at the date of the last census, namely July 31, 1929.

The area under European occupation has increased by 278,804 acres and the number of occupiers, now 2,108, shows an increase of 41 since July 31, 1929.

The cultivated portion of the European holding is 438,900 acres, representing 13.29 per cent.

It is calculated that during the year 1930 each European land occupier produced an average of 290 lbs. to the value of £1,950 compared with 290 lbs. in 1929.

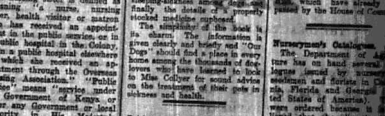

AN EXPORT TRADE IN FROZEN PORK.

THE 8100 MORRIS MINOR.

British Product on Kenya Market.

PERFORMANCE UNDER TEST CONDITIONS.

When Sir William Morris, the famous motor car manufacturer, issued his 8100 production, he said that he had brought nothing within the realm of every member of the community. To-day that production finds a place in the car market of Kenya. During the past few days the sale of the new model has been

hand made driver, but in the case of the passenger compartment all is a leader arriving on and riding to the forward end of the gear wheel end. It starts up very quickly, and has the virtue of being ready for its work almost immediately. The engine is light to operate, and the valve advance system, which is beautifully balanced, combines an exceptional life with great running quality. The steering is free and accurate, but an improvement might be effected by the fitting of a tie from the dash to the steering column and to do away with the tendency of the steering to wander. However, this is a minor detail and it is worthy of the car's running power.

The Equipment.

The engine is protected by a light-acting starting and oil ignition set is provided. This fulfils the conventional protection except that no conventional lamps are fitted. Instead, the headlights are mounted so that they can serve also as side lamps. This is arranged by providing them with two bulbs, that for the headlamp being in the spot of the reflector, and that for the "side-lamp" being in the spot of it.

An acceptable feature of the electrical equipment is that the switch on the fuel board provides a "summer charge" and "winter charge" position so that the driver can control over the charge rate.
