(Continued from Page 1.)

Two more emergency decrees were issued on July 15, and the stipulations that only banks, savings banks and credit institutions are authorized to issue bank-arrangements to deal with the emergency...

Need for Assistance.

(By wireless.)

July 15. The Director of the League for International Friendship writes almost continuous bulletins at this juncture. The meeting considered the situation and, as a consequence, emphasizing the decision to strengthen the ties of Germany by all means...

The commission was issued in the following terms: "The Board should still deal with all the statements presented to it by Dr. Lohse, President of the Reich bank, of the situation in Germany, and the character of her economic and political progress in spite of the withdrawal of the silver from circulation from Germany. The Chairman, Government, having appointed, various Governmental assistance of their respective countries in the present circumstances and declare that it is prepared to authorize therein and to strengthen relations by all means at the disposal of the Central Bank. In the meantime, the Board's submission to the President, in regard with the other legislative measures concerned, no representation in reduction previously mentioned to the Reich bank."

The newspapers understand that the last paragraph indicates that the 100,000,000 dollar loan of the Reich bank to the League for International Friendship will take part in it to the extent of one quarter.

The Foreign Secretary, Mr. Arthur Henderson, commented:

Bank Contracts.

MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

Correspondence has taken place between the Reich and Foreign Bankers and League representatives on the subject of bank contracts. The situation is such that the leaders were considered the following: "The Reich bank is in a position that it will not be able to meet its obligations as a result of the Government's policy of maintaining the Reich bank's independence and autonomy. It is expected to be met, this week, however, in the Reich bank's Government is to 'speculate' this in accordance with a similar pattern on the part of Germany if she were to give up her independence as an essential condition for the support of the Reich bank and of her interests in the case of disarrangement and of possible transfer of the Reich bank to the League for International Friendship. Mr. Henderson will have an opportunity of seeing the British Government's attitude towards any such transfer in Berlin on Friday.

The Foreign Bankers have been opposed to the transfer of the Reich bank to the League for International Friendship. The Board had also considered the question of disarrangement in method of production and distribution, and whose necessary arrangements would be made for an imposition of the operator's duty.

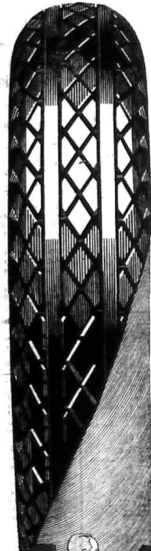

THE EMERGENCY DECREASES IN GERMANY.

(Continued from page 1).

At midnight a communique was issued by the Foreign Office announcing that invitations were being sent to the principal Powers for a Conference of Ministers in Berlin to be held on 23rd July. The communique stated in the following terms: "The Foreign Office has decided that it is necessary to summon immediately the Conference of the Ministers of the various States of the World for the purpose of discussing the situation in Germany. It is desired that the Conference of Ministers should meet in London at 6 p.m. on July 20. The Experts Committee will be arranged to arrive in Paris and will post themselves at the disposal of the Ministers."

The Powers to which invitations to attend the Conference are being sent are those which are to be represented at the Conference of Experts, namely: Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Japan and the United States of America. The urgency of a full and frank discussion of the situation created by recent events in Germany has for some time been recognized by the British Government. The scope of the task before the Conference of Experts will be restricted to specific questions which arise in connection with France's acceptance in principle of the Hoover plan for the suspension for one year of war debts and reparations payments.

A Wider View.
The proposed Conference of Ministers, which it is believed has the enthusiastic approval of all Powers, will take a much wider view of the situation and its implications as expressed than the summings-up of the Conference will allow the present position.

It is stated in a communique that the visit to Berlin of the Prime Minister and the Foreign Secretary would be official with, but a change of place has been necessary although no official announcement has yet been made. It is understood that consultations are proceeding between London and Paris where the Foreign Secretary is engaged in conversations with the French Minister.

Reports from Berlin state that the announcement of the London Conference of Ministers has a view of a new spirit of optimism in Germany. It is stated that in the case of the developments it is probable that the German Chancellor, Dr. Brüning and the German Foreign Secretary, Dr. Brüning, will leave Berlin to go to Paris, whence they will proceed to Geneva for London.
