HOSTILITIES IN MANCHURIA.

FIGHTING IN NORTHERN AREA.

Chinese Troops Driven Back.

HEAVY CASUALTIES REPORTED.

Japan Declines to Withdraw Her Forces.

Hostilities between Japanese and Chinese troops have broken out in Northern Manchuria, where it is stated the Chinese retreated, after some days fighting, in the utmost confusion into a walled city near the border.

It is also reported that the heaviest casualties in the latest fighting since the Great War occurred during the battle. Three Japanese aeroplanes were also damaged by machine-gun fire. It is stated that the body of a Soviet officer was found among the Chinese dead.

The Council of the League of Nations has issued a warning to both Governments to call a halt to further incidents as they make it even more difficult for the Council to pursue its efforts in the maintenance of peace. There could be no question of any withdrawal of Japanese troops into the railway zone of Manchuria if Japan declines to give a definite guarantee as to the safety of Japanese subjects.

Commenting on the situation, "The Times" states that it is regrettable that the Japanese Government's hands were forced by the military leaders, as Japan has a very good case in regard to Manchuria and an ill-considered inquiry might have established that justice was on her side.

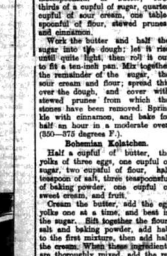

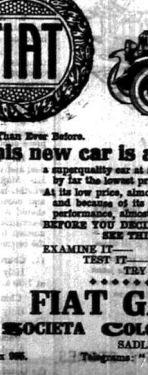

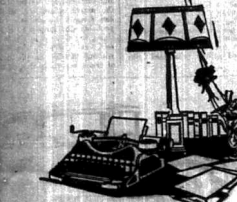

A PERENNIAL LEGUME

Kudus is coming very into favour in the southern states of the Union of South Africa (see the Union of South Africa (see the Union of South Africa) by the Kenya Department of Agriculture, has been introduced into Kenya and a few notes on its behaviour at the Kenyan Experiment Station will be found at the end of this article. The Department of Agriculture has a small amount of planting material available, in regard to which enquiries should be addressed to the Agricultural Officer, South Agricultural Experiment Station. The following are extracts from the literature on this subject:

There is a need for a perennial forage plant which will produce large yields of hay, which is adapted to grazing by livestock, and which is sufficiently unpalatable to the stock to prevent them from overgrazing it.

Kudus is a perennial legume which, as a forage plant, is either the green or the dried material, and which is sufficiently unpalatable to the stock to prevent them from overgrazing it.

As a Hay and Grazing Crop. Feeding Value.—A comparison of the feeding value of kudus with that of other legumes and green states is presented in Table 2. It will be seen that kudus is not only as good a forage as other legumes, but also that it is more palatable than alfalfa.

Table 2. Comparative Feeding Value of Kudus and Alfalfa.

Although it would probably not be expected that kudus may grow so freely in the "dry" season as the field and low-lying vegetation of the country, it would be especially valuable during periods of extremely dry weather when other crops fail.

Yields of Kudus.

A well-established planting of kudus in a field near the Agricultural Officer's Station at the Kenyan Experiment Station, in 1919-20, gave a yield of 12,000 lbs. of hay per acre during the first 10 months of the year. This yield was equal to that of a similar crop of alfalfa.

When it is being mown, kudus will withstand a heavy load of stock. It has been shown to grow at least two full seasons before being cut in the field.

One of the objections to kudus as a hay crop is the difficulty of curing it. This is especially true of the material which is cut in the field and is not dried immediately by the sun.

On the basis of the above, it would be expected that kudus may grow so freely in the "dry" season as the field and low-lying vegetation of the country, it would be especially valuable during periods of extremely dry weather when other crops fail.

Grass. Grass is a natural food of kudus readily and a field of it may be used effectively as a temporary pasture when regular summer pastures fail on account of drought. The Department of Animal Husbandry had taken up the Kudus Experiment Station, which was established in 1919. The work with this plant during the winter of July 1919, the milk flow of dairy cows was increased by changing them from grass pastures to kudus a feet and a half. Unfortunately, the area was too small for the number of cows used and no record was obtained which would indicate the grazing capacity of an acre of kudus. No unpleasant effects of any kind were noted from the use of kudus as a forage.

Observation of kudus which has been grazed and results of mowing experiments in data indicate that it should be cut more closely throughout the growing season. However, the most desirable time for grazing this crop and the quantity to which it may be grazed will be determined by additional experiments. In order to maintain a stand, it is advised that kudus should be cut once or twice every 10 days to remove from it the effects of mowing or grazing; this will help to keep the kudus on the field and on the stock.

The results in table 4 show that the yields of crops sown after kudus are higher than those sown after other crops. The average yield of crops sown after kudus is 5,800 lbs. per acre, compared with 4,200 lbs. per acre for other crops. This is a 38% increase in yield.

Since kudus plants are so scarce in the field, it is advisable for farmers to obtain a few plants to set a small area of ground which will produce a crop of kudus in a short time. 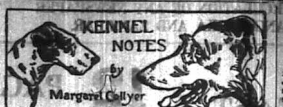

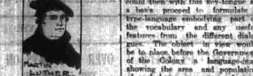

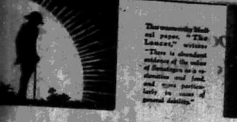
