ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE.

To Set Pace in Progress of Uganda.

FINANCE ENQUIRY SEQUEL.

Permanent Body with Director of Agriculture as Chairman.

The Finance Committee appointed by the Government of Uganda gave careful consideration to the question of increased production believing that a greater bulk of exports was the only means at the disposal of the country to compensate the public revenue for the losses due to lower produce prices.

In this connection the most valuable recommendation made by the Committee is that there should be appointed a body to consider the Economic Development Committee charged with the duty of submitting to Government proposals for increasing the country's productivity by extending the area under established crops and improving native methods and by introducing and developing new crops.

It is suggested that this Committee should be under the chairmanship of the Director of Agriculture and be widely representative of the Administration and of native producers.

Having discussed the question of central markets it is proposed in the Report that this should be left to the examination and advice of the Economic Development Committee.

The basis of the cotton tax was also examined and the Committee recommended that when the price of American middling fell to five pence or below no cotton tax should be imposed in Uganda. Happily for the Government, the abandonment of the Gold Standard has brought out an automatic increase in values of over 20 per cent.

The Cotton Tax Position.

The last section of the second report of the Uganda Finance Committee extracts from a paper submitted by the Finance Committee on the subject of the cotton tax. It is the most important item in the report and of economic importance there should be no cotton tax in Uganda until the price of American middling falls to five pence or below.

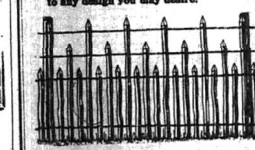

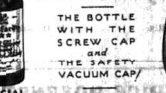

The following are the principal elements of the scheme:

Class 1.—The Administration of the Ports and Railways of the Colony is empowered to establish and operate the transport of merchandise by motor vehicles, on all the motor vehicles in connection with railway stations in order to achieve a more efficient and economic service.
