Elected Members' Advice Ignored.

DRASTIC ECONOMY NEEDED.

Reports of Enquiries Not Put Into Force.

The debate on the 1910 Estimates was continued in the Executive Council on Monday and yesterday by the Elected Members of the Government. The terms of the report of the Select Committee, set out on the front page of this paper, represent the views of the majority of its members, but not of the official minority.

During the previous condition of the country's finances, which was reported in the country's Finance Report, it was stated that the advice given by the Elected Members earlier in the year for the Government to investigate the situation, had been ignored.

The Elected Members during the course of the debate indicated a number of further avenues of enquiry, which had been put forward in the Select Committee, but had not been adopted by Government, while the opinion was expressed that the estimates of revenue were unfairly optimistic, particularly in regard to the customs figures.

Government was also charged with having broken promises that reports of enquiries into various activities of Government, had not been put into effect.

"Lethargy and Dilatoriness."
