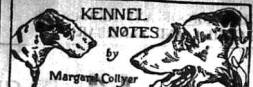

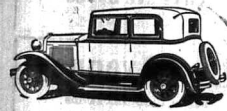

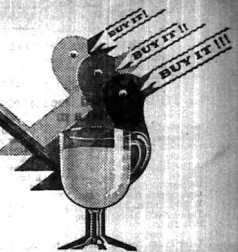

## Governor's Estimate of Value of Man Power.

ONLY £500 IN CASH.

### Dense Vegetation Greatest Handicap To More Effective Campaign.

During the recent and final speech to Legislative Council on the Government of Uganda, Sir William Gordon, defended the Protectorate administration's policy of inaction—during the early months of the locust infestation in the early months of 1917.

He contended that by organised communal attacks on eggs and hoppers and by burning, ditching, bush trees, etc., five million man days had been devoted to anti-locust and at 30 cents a day this would have cost £2,500,000. He added a further £25,000 for unorganised individuals.

He pointed out, however, that the actual cash disbursement had been only £500 of which £340 represented transport expenses of supervising officers.

### Reply to Critics.

The total expenditure to date by the Government of Uganda in the locust campaign has been £100,000. It is of course obvious, however, that this is not a very indicative of the work done in the Protectorate. The Governor's estimate of the value of man power is £2,500,000. 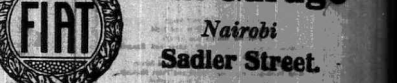
