He also challenged other statements and said that the latter propaganda conducted by Lord Olivier and others was doing grave injury to racial relations in East Africa.

Lord Olivier has now written a letter to "The Times" in which he quotes references from the "East African Standard," but all of an infernal nature, and no positive statement by Sir Edward Grigg is given.

Conclusion.

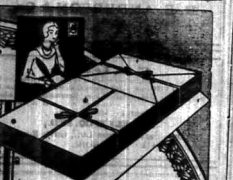

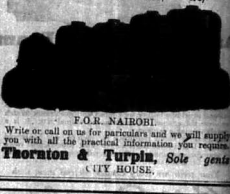
