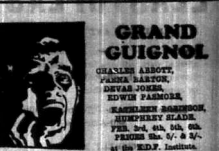

That the outbreak had been carefully planned is revealed by the discovery of hidden weapons in the cells.

Trouble Brewing for Some Time.

London, January 19.—The Dartmoor prison, Devon, has been the scene of a serious outbreak of trouble which has resulted in the death of six convicts and the wounding of six warders.
