The Threat of Income Tax. OPOSED TO BEST INTERESTS OF THE COLONY.

Convention's Views. COMMITTEE APPOINTED TO WATCH DEVELOPMENTS.

The view of the Convention of Associations expressed last year ago that income tax for Kenya was unjust, unpalatable and unworkable in the conditions then existing in the Colony was endorsed during the present session of the Convention when the hope was expressed that Government would make no attempt to reimpose the tax already once abandoned.

While a very small minority, led by one of the Elected Members, approved of the principle of income tax, the delegates were unanimously of the opinion that it would be bad policy to introduce it at the present time.

It was decided to appoint a small representative committee to watch income tax development and to report progress periodically to the Elected Members of the Convention. The committee consists of the Executive Committee of Association of Chambers of Commerce of Eastern Africa.

The threat of income tax was referred to by one of the Elected Members as "this hydra-headed dragon."

Convention of Associations, at Wajale, reaffirmed the opinion expressed in 1922 that the form of income tax under the existing provisions in Kenya is essentially unworkable in the conditions existing in the Colony, and generally disapproved of the proposals of the Government to reimpose such a tax in Kenya. The Convention was satisfied that such attempts could only meet with the most determined opposition from all sections of the community.

The resolution, which was adopted by the Convention, stated that the Government should not attempt to reimpose income tax, particularly in the form of a tax on the profits of business, until such a time as the general conditions of the Colony had improved to such an extent that the necessary conditions for the successful introduction of such a tax had been met.

The previous intention to impose income tax was abandoned because of the fact that the necessary conditions for the successful introduction of such a tax had not been met.

There were those who would say that income tax was a necessary condition to the development of the Colony, but the Convention was of the opinion that it was not.
