[TROMBON BRYER'S AGONY.] Dublin, March 30. The origin of cyclones, weather systems and depressions is to be investigated by an International Meteorological Commission in which 20 countries will participate. This agency will be in celebration of the jubilee of the first international Polar year 1958 (the last of the present day).

The Commission will spend over a year, starting on August 1, at a number of stations in the Polar regions, and will endeavour to ascertain data concerning currents, temperatures, magnetic activity, etc.

[TROMBON BRYER'S AGONY.] London, March 30. The significant conclusion that youthful crime continues to increase every year is drawn from criminal statistics for England and Wales during 1959 just issued by the Home Office.

The report shows that during the year the number of young offenders was 12,000 compared with 11,000 in 1958. The total represents an increase of 10 per cent over the preceding year.

The greater part of the increase is due to crimes committed against property. Crimes of violence, such as murder, manslaughter, robbery and highway robbery, showed a decrease of 10 per cent over the preceding year.


