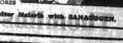



Kikuyu reserves while others are being built. Two Co-operative Societies are being formed, and white men are receiving education in the industrial arts, and providing as though the Reserves were an independent country, an Association for the same purpose, though not a Co-operative Society, has been established. Large quantities of produce have already been disposed of in this manner and it is had the effect of raising prices of produce in the areas in which the organizations operate, even for sale outside such organizations.

The work described above is handicapped for lack of staff owing to the present financial stringency. Work of agricultural improvement and development in many areas requires well-trained agricultural officers of suitable personality. This is perhaps the most important limiting factor but there are others which should not be out of sight of, judging the value of service for Native agricultural development.

It must always be borne in mind that the material "morbidity" of the British Colonies and the consequent depressed satisfaction in a mode of life which merely creates land and allows them to subsist.



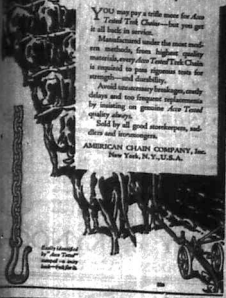
