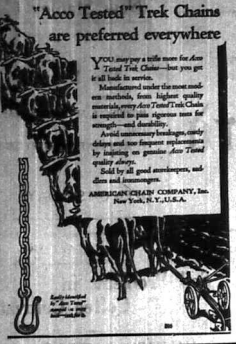

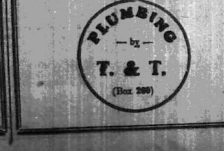

Extensive Damage by Locust Swarms. MAIZE AND SUGAR CANE SUFFER FROM INFESTATION.

The heavy swarms of locusts continue to do much damage to the crops in the districts mentioned, but in addition, sugar cane has been greatly damaged.

GAZE OF STOCK PRUNING BEING HASTENED.

An intensive campaign of hogger destruction continues in all parts of the country. The Department of Agriculture, as a result of their efforts certain parts of the country are free of locusts.

Extensive damage, however, has been reported from various quarters, notably in the Nzoia Province, in the Nyanza Province, and in the Taita hills at the coast. The maize crops have suffered chiefly in the districts mentioned, but in addition, sugar cane has been greatly damaged.

The Department states that some of stock pruning have recently occurred, as a result of locust having been applied at a heavier rate per acre than has been recommended. A warning is issued that locusts should not be stocked until sufficient rain has fallen to wash the anemio into the ground or until it is certain that all locusts are destroyed.

Little Change in Situation.

The following report on the locust situation in Kenya Colony, for the week ending June 30, has been issued by the Kenya Department of Agriculture:

Reports that there is little change in the position. There has been a gradual increase in the number of flying swarms, especially all of the new season, although in many areas the direction of flight has been reversed. There appears in the Northern Provinces a greater extent of infestation in north-western districts.

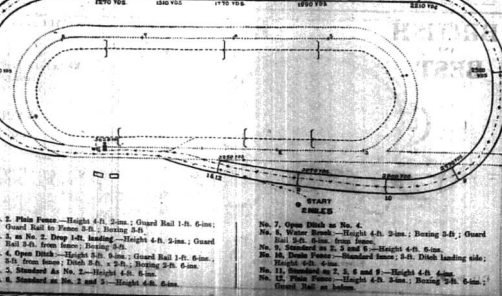
