"War Guilt" Clause to Cease to Have Effect.

MAIN PROVISIONS OF REVISED SCHEME. After lengthy conferences at Lausanne between the representatives of the Allies and Germany, it is announced that an agreement has been drawn up providing for the future payment of reparation payments by Germany.

The new treaty is a document of 2,500 words, includes the abrogation of the reparations clauses of the Versailles Treaty, and a statement that the "war guilt" clause shall cease to have effect. Other conditions provide for an annual payment by Germany of a sum of 1,000 million marks of a given sum to the European Reconstruction Fund, and an agreement by signatories not to disturb the world economic peace.

An earlier message from Lausanne stated that a meeting on the previous night resulted in a deadlock, both the French and German representatives having refused to sign the Mr. Ramsay MacDonald, however, declined to admit.

Britain and Italy have also reached agreement regarding war debts, the nature of which removes certain Italian obligations. Details will be announced later.

Italian Funds Removed.

["STANDARD CORRESPONDENT."] London, July 8. 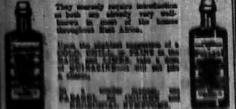

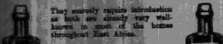
