## PROPOSAL EMBODIED IN A NEW BILL.

Women Included.

IF IN RECEIPT OF £15  
A MONTH.

As published by the Kenya Government yesterday, and which will be introduced at the forthcoming session of the Legislative Council, provides for the imposition of an extra payment of the Non-Native Poll Tax this year.

The object of this legislation is to obtain additional revenue during the remaining months of the current year which, in view of the financial position is urgently needed.

Persons who are in receipt of incomes of an average of £15 per month between January 1 and September 30, whether from a private source or as remuneration for employment, will also be called upon to pay the tax. Employers will be required to furnish returns of women employed at salaries of not less than £15 a month during the specific period.

Persons who reached the age of 18 years on or before July 1 have also been included among those liable to pay the tax.

The Bill is a temporary measure and will expire at the end of the year.

## Temporary Measure.

It is believed that by assessing the tax in this manner the Government will be able to realize the revenue needed to meet its obligations under the Bill of the additional tax not previously levied on the non-native population.

## MR. RAMSAY MACDONALD TO DEAL WITH ILL-INFORMED SPECULATION.

The Lausanne Agreement has received the full approval of both the French and the German Cabinets, and it is now to be considered by the British Cabinet tomorrow morning prior to a settlement being made by the Prime Minister in the House of Commons, in the afternoon.

It was anticipated that Mr. Ramsay Macdonald would deal in detail with certain points of the settlement regarding which there has been ill-informed speculation. He will also make it clear that the Conference has left the signatory powers quite free of any "secret agreements".

He declared that while representative bodies could be set up to discuss economic recovery but that the results of Lausanne would be a settlement of the reparations question. Until Germany receives aid as a world factor there could be no recovery for us.

Referring to the so-called "Gentlemen's Agreement" he said that the Lausanne Conference was a success. Mr. MacDonald said that there was no need to worry about the Lausanne Conference. 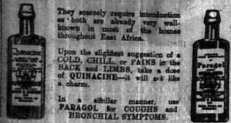

SUMMARY OF THE CENSUS REPORT.

March, 1931 to February, 1932.

NOT UNLUCKY DISQUIETING IN SPITE OF LOCUSTS AND DEPRESSION.

Advance review of the report of the Kenya Agricultural Commission for the year from March, 1931 to February, 1932 has been issued by the Department of Agriculture, and sets out the more important facts concerning the development and production on European holdings.

The report states that though it was expected that locust depression would be present in the year, the situation was shown to be unduly disappointing. Livestock, tea and coffee, particularly, made steady progress. The principal agricultural exports during the period under review are valued at £1,400,000 in value, but only by 18.5 per cent. in tonnage as compared with the previous year. Tea increased by 11 per cent. in average and by 61 per cent. in production.
