Hopes Abandoned in Dublin.

BRITAIN'S OFFER OF ARBITRATION STILL HOLDS GOOD.

Following the efforts of Mr. Norton, the Irish Labour Party, to find a way out of the dispute between Britain and the Irish Free State, Mr. de Valera paid a rapid visit to London and interviewed Mr. Ramsey MacDonald.

The conference, however, was abortive as Mr. de Valera refused to accept the previous position. Mr. de Valera returned the following night to Dublin.

Mr. Macdonald, who has left London for a rest at Lillersmead, expressed his disappointment at the failure of the negotiations. He indicated that the offer of arbitration still held good.

It is stated from Dublin that hopes for a peaceful settlement have been abandoned and that the economic war will begin when the Irish Dublin Bill is enacted. The Bill has been passed by the Dail and the Senate has no power to amend it.

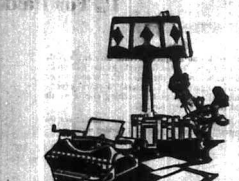

# The Future of Zanziar's Clove Industry.

## IMPROVED METHODS OF CULTIVATION.

### Coping with Competition.

#### REPORT OF INVESTIGATION BY DIRECTOR OF IMPERIAL FOREST INSTITUTE.

In investigation into methods of clove cultivation, and recommendations as to the way in which the industry in Zanzibar may be assured an adequate export, recently finished, F.R.S. is published by C.I.E., D.Sc. (Oxon.), F.R.S., N. S. Troop, Imperial Forest Institute.

At the request of the Zanzibar Government Professor Troop visited the island in 1934. The conclusions at present prevailing in regard to the clove industry are suggested that attention should be paid to the improvement of existing clove areas rather than the experimental work should be undertaken. Improving in methods of picking and experiments in pruning are also required.

One of the greatest dangers to Zanzibar's clove industry today is in regard to synthetic substitutes which are being manufactured in other countries. The latest information on this subject, which has been summarized by the Imperial Institute, is reproduced in the course of the report.

### Position Regarding Synthetic Substitutes

As the invitation of the Zanzibar Government, Professor F. R. S. Troop, F.R.S., Director of Forestry in the Imperial Forest Institute, visited Zanzibar in 1934 to investigate the question of clove production and its export to other countries.

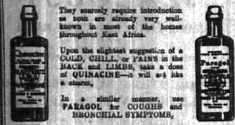

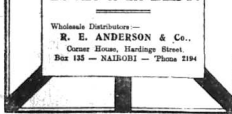

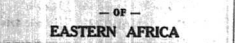
