PROPOSAL FOR IMMEDIATE WORLD CONFERENCE.

War Debts and Disarmament.

OUTLINE OF SCHEME PROPOSED BY SENATOR BOAH.

An important move is on foot in the United States where it has been suggested by Senator Borah that an immediate World Conference shall be held to consider the question of war debts, disarmament, the re-establishment of the gold standard and the stabilization of silver in the Orient.

Added significance is given to this announcement by the fact that up to now Senator Borah has been one of the strongest opponents of the revision of war debts. There is believed to be a growing conviction in America that trade is being hampered by the maintenance of the present European liabilities.

The Gold Standard.

[REDACTED] New York, July 24. A move that is regarded as most significant has been made by Senator Borah, Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, in his proposal for an immediate World Conference to consider the revision of war debts, disarmament, the re-

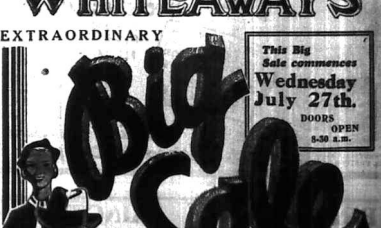

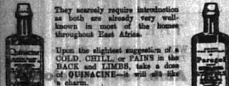

The Kenya Government has decided to introduce a Bill to the Budget session of the Legislative Council providing for the imposition of Income Tax next year.

It was one of the most interesting announcements made by His Excellency the Governor yesterday in an address to Council. The Governor said he believed that a case for a low Income Tax was unanswerable and that the proposal would meet with the approval of a large section of the community.

He expected that an expert from Somerset House will arrive in the Colony shortly in order to advise the Government on the necessary legislation and to set up the requisite administrative machinery.

There is a strong probability that Income tax will also be introduced into Uganda and Tanganyika and in that case it is expected that those countries will share the expense attached to employment of the expert.

His Excellency announced that the shortfall on this year's estimates is likely to amount to £300,000.

In addition to the economies already found possible, the increased levy on the salaries of Civil Servants and the proposed additional poll tax, the Petrol Consumption Tax is increased as from yesterday by twenty cents a gallon.

It was stated that indications are that the Customs revenue this year will be £100,000 less than in 1931.

In conclusion the Governor said "The future is still obscure, but signs are not wanting of a move in the direction of some improvement of conditions. Meanwhile our best hope lies in a move in the direction of some remedying of the difficulties which surround us, but in all doing our best and working together."

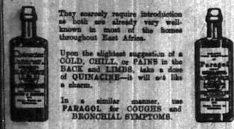

TO TAKE EFFECT FROM YESTERDAY.

Irish Free State Emergency Duties have been issued in two installments, one section dealing with goods from the United Kingdom and the other of general application.

Among the items referred to in the United Kingdom are, and on which a duty of five shillings per ton in excess of the normal amount, for a period of three months, sugar and sweetened foods, while those of general application include lard and potatoes.

The duties are levied on all potatoes and wheat imported into the Irish Free State. It is understood that the Government are already taking the necessary steps to secure a sufficient supply of these articles in the event of a shortage.

Mr. Henry Parnell, the Minister for Finance, has expressed his views on the proposed duties. He stated that the Government are not opposed to a government which is not in a position to pay the duties, but that it is their duty to ensure that the duties are paid.

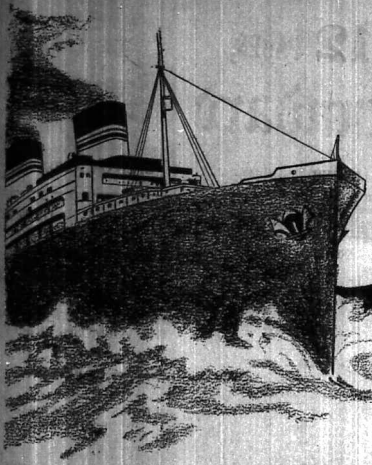
