Nazi Gains in German Reichstag Elections.

BUT INSUFFICIENT FOR CLEAR MAJORITY

Enthusiastic Polling.

SURPRISE INCREASE IN NUMBER OF COMMUNISTS RETURNED.

The Nazis have more than doubled their representation in the Reichstag as a result of the general election held throughout Germany on Sunday. In spite of their large increase in number of seats gained, however, they will still be unable to command an absolute majority, even with the support of allied parties.

The Centre Party, led by Dr. Brüning, the Vice-Chancellor, holds the balance of power, which it is expected that in view of the statement of the Von Papen Government will remain in office. This is considered how to the Nazis.

The Communists made a remarkable recovery following their setback in the 1933 elections. In spite of the hostility of Herr von Papen, and of the Nazis, they were not excluded from the representation by the Nazis. In Greater Berlin the Communists gained heavily at the expense of the Nazis and Socialists.

It is stated that the elections were a triumph for the German sense of discipline, an advance over 80 per cent of the population voted and the pollings were extremely enthusiastic, everything passed off comparatively peacefully with very few disturbances on any section day, although 10 people were killed on the eve of the poll.

AFRICANS NOW ESTIMATED TO OWN 12,000,000 HEAD OF CATTLE.

It is estimated that the livestock owned by natives in Kenya must approximate 12,000,000 head. Overstocking has become a serious problem for the Government, and is a big problem for the Administration.

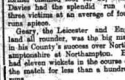

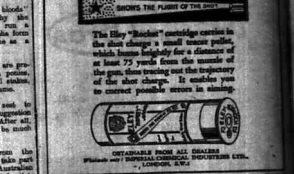
