# Britain's Dairy Produce Supplies in 1931.

**THE EMPIRE SETS UP A NEW BUTTER RECORD.**

## The Peak of the Pig-Cycle.

HUGE IMPORTS OF BACON AND CONDENSED MILK.

Britain now imports more butter by value than any other single commodity. In 1931 Britain had more for imported bacon than for imported wheat. Imports of condensed milk in the same period were also larger than ever, with the exception of the abnormal imports just after the war. And many more interesting facts are revealed in the new report by the Empire Marketing Board, on "Dairy Products in 1931."

In regard to butter it is of particular interest to note that among the Empire countries mentioned as increasing their exports of butter to the United Kingdom South Africa and Kenya are specially mentioned.

Over 3,000,000 eggs reached the United Kingdom during the year and the report states that the per capita consumption is about 140. The volume of bacon supplies was the largest ever recorded and accounted for about 24 per cent. of the total imports.

## Increase in Home Production of Eggs.

The United Kingdom is the world's largest importer of dairy products, which accounts on one quarter of the total supply consumed in the Empire. A seasonal difference in price between imports and home production is a feature of the trade. According to October, October imports of bacon amounted to £6,071,000 worth, while at £4,965,000 in 1930—nearly 20 per cent. less. Imports of bacon before the war, when, however, were much larger than imports in 1930, what is more the Irish Free State has been a large importer of bacon. Supplies of bacon from Empire countries have not risen over 10 per cent. since 1914, though the report considers "Empire bacon" to be the largest element of the total imports as appears from the following table. Never in any previous year have Empire countries accounted for so large a share of the United Kingdom bacon imports.

### LARGE INCREASES.

We are a importing considerately more bacon than we did in the years before the war. Our imports last year rose to £4,705,000 worth, or £1,100,000 extra, valued in 1931, at £5,805,000. The increase has not risen by very much, however, and the increase from 1930 to 1931 was from 600,000 cents to 130,000 cents, and imports by 1931 had doubled and were valued at £4,000,000. We are also taking more bacon from Canada and settled park, and slightly less from fresh pork.
