DEATH SENTENCES ON NAZIS COMMITTED TO HARD LABOUR FOR LIFE.

A mass meeting of 15,000 members of the 'Steel Helmets' Organization in Berlin was attended by the ex-Governor Prince and other members of the ex-Kaiser's family. The fact that Cabinet Ministers of the Reich as well as of Prussia were present is regarded as clearly indicating that Herr von Papen will support the 'Steel Helmets' rather than the Nazi Storm Troops.

The leader of the 'Steel Helmets' urged the abrogation of the Versailles Treaty and the Weimar Constitution and the re-introduction of compulsory military service and declared that the Party system had collapsed and the life of the soldier had ended.

THE DECREASE IN VALUE OF PRODUCE EXPORTED.

A Difficult Period.

BUT NO GROUNDS FOR UNDO PESSIMISM SAYS DIRECTOR OF AGRICULTURE.

The total value of agricultural exports, the produce of Kenya, in 1931, was £2,657,297, a decrease of £1,611,000 over the total value of the previous year. The decrease in value is only 18.5 per cent, compared with 35.5 per cent in 1930. The quantities exported during 1931 were actually greater than in any year except 1926 when the tonnage was actually high due to a large export of maize.

Regarding the prevailing conditions, the Director says that no grounds for undue pessimism and the situation is not without some encouraging features. He says the Director of Agriculture in reporting to his Department for last year...

Among the more favourable aspects of a difficult year is the fact that the number of occupiers has not diminished, whilst the production of such areas per acre is not regarded as necessarily a retrogressive movement.

The coffee industry showed steady progress; the output of plant fibre suffered a smaller reduction than in 1930; wheat is being exported; production of iron increased substantially; and the live stock industry made steady progress in regard to numbers.
