Mr. W. McEllan Wilson presented a memorandum explaining the situation of land occupation in the Kyambu area in 1900 when he first had personal knowledge of the district. He stated that in 1902 when he took up his present farm there were only Kikuyu near but three or four miles, and they were only the adventurous of the tribe.

The land beyond Kyambu, and through Kamiti to Ruiru was originally in the hands of the Masai and there were well evidences of their occupation in the form of cattle tracks and mannyias. Mr. McEllan Wilson stated other substantives to support this contention.

Mr. McEllan Wilson added that the Kikuyu only began to occupy the land in the Kyambu district between the years 1903-5, having migrated there from the north beyond the Ohantia. More Kikuyu came down from the uplands as European settlement increased.


